2011 CONCRETE SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION CITY OF SHEBOYGAN, WI

BID NO. 2351-11

Owner and Work: The City of Sheboygan hereby gives notice that sealed public bids will be received for the concrete sidewalk installation of new sidewalks, crosswalks, replacement of old sidewalks and associated concrete work at various locations throughout the city. The major work of this contract is generally described as follows:

- 13,500 SF remove concrete sidewalk and approaches; 100 SF concrete pavement removal; 100 LF remove curb and gutter; 200 SF remove integral sidewalk/curb; 50 CY excessive cut; 50 CY excessive fill, gravel; 13,500 SF install 4" concrete sidewalk; 500 SF install 6" concrete sidewalk; 100 LF install 30" curb and gutter; 100 S.F. install 7" concrete aprons; 50 LF install 6" concrete curb; 200 SF install integral sidewalk and curb; 50 LF concrete sawing; 500 SF grading for new sidewalk; 60 SY 4" topsoil, seed, fertilizer; 200 SF install 6" concrete sidewalk with panel finish; 10 EA install curb ramp detectable warning field. Root grinding and removal shall be incidental to the contract.

Time and Place of Bid Opening: Sealed bids will be received by the City of Sheboygan, WI, in the office of the Engineering Division, located at 2026 New Jersey Avenue, from pre-qualified bidders until **10:30 a.m., Local Time on Tuesday, March 15th, 2011**, at which time and location bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Bidding Documents: Project proposal and specifications may be examined and obtained from the Engineering Office, 2026 New Jersey Avenue, Sheboygan, WI, between the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. for a Twenty Dollar (**\$20**) per set, non-refundable fee. All checks shall be made payable to the City of Sheboygan. These documents will be mailed upon request. Please note, however, if you request mailing to be sent "via Overnight"; an additional fee of \$25 is required. No partial sets will be issued.

Pre-Bid Qualification: All bidders shall be required to file or have on file a valid Bidder's Proof of Responsibility form with the Engineering Division, City of Sheboygan, **not less than five (5) days prior to the time of opening of these bids.** Only bidders who have demonstrated their qualifications to perform the work will be permitted to bid. **Forms are included in the bid documents.**

Bid and Contract Security: A certified check or satisfactory Bid Bond, payable to the City of Sheboygan, WI, in an amount not less than five (5%) percent of the bid, shall accompany each bid as a guarantee that, if the bid is accepted, the bidder will execute and file the contract, Contract Performance Bond, Payment Bond and the Certificate of Insurance as required by the contract documents within ten (10) days after the Notice of Award of the Contract by the City. In case the bidder fails to file such contract with bond and insurance within the time stated, the amount of the check or bid bond shall be forfeited to the City as liquidated damages.

State Wage Rates: The minimum wage rate to be paid on this project shall not be less than the prevailing minimum wage rate determination on file as set up by the Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development (DWD), pursuant to Section 66.293 (3) of the Wisconsin Statutes and shall apply to all work completed in this contract.

The contractor and all subcontractors working on a project that has been issued prevailing wage rate determinations by the DWD shall file certified payroll reports in an electronic format that meets DWD's reporting requirements.

Bid Withdrawal: No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the scheduled opening of the bids without the consent of the City of Sheboygan.

Legal Provisions: This contract letting shall be subject to the provisions of Section 62.15, 66.0901, 66.0903 and 779.15 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
