



GETTING INVOLVED: BECOME A POLL WORKER

The State Elections Board (SEB) encourages all private citizens to vote and to become involved in the election process. One of the most rewarding ways to do this is to become an Election Day poll worker (or "Election Inspector" as the position is formally called).

Citizen involvement is essential to conduct open, accurate and fair elections in Wisconsin. The State Elections Board hopes that you will consider participation in one of these positions. To help you make an informed decision about this, the Wisconsin State Elections Board has prepared the following Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's) about being an Election Inspector:
