### Nature of Work:

Under general supervision, performs journeyman level automotive and truck repair as required of a certified heavy duty truck mechanic, performs non-motorized equipment repair, and performs related work as required.

### Typical Duties: (These examples do not list all the duties which may be assigned.)

- 1.\* Performs all types of automotive, truck, and equipment repairs including electrical, mechanical, and hydraulic repairs.
- 2.\* Maintains, repairs, and overhauls all motorized and non-motorized equipment.
- 3.\* Performs all types of body work, including painting and refinishing on trucks and equipment.
4. Assists in instructing other personnel.
- 5.\* Fabricates, welds, and performs structural and framing work.
6. Keeps records and makes reports.
- 7.\* Performs related work as assigned.

### \*Essential Functions

### Minimum Qualifications:

1. Must maintain certification by NIASE as a general heavy duty truck mechanic. This includes certification in diesel and gasoline engines.
2. Previous experience as a journeyman level truck mechanic.
3. Thorough knowledge of trade practices, methods, tools, and equipment in the automotive and truck trade.
4. Considerable ability in diagnosing mechanical failures and defects.
5. Considerable knowledge of occupational hazards and safe work practices.

6. Working knowledge and experience in welding and fabricating.
7. Physical strength to perform heavy repair work, requiring lifting, bending, standing and laying.
8. Ability to work from parts and maintenance manuals and written and/or oral instructions.
9. Ability to keep accurate records and make reports.
10. Possession of a valid Wisconsin Motor Vehicle Operator's license.
11. Must have Commercial Driver's License (CDL) and appropriate endorsements upon hire or attain same by completion of probationary period.
