Nature of Work:

Under general supervision, performs a variety of skilled electrical work and performs related work as required.

Typical Duties: (These examples do not list all the duties which may be assigned.)

- 1.* Installs and maintains traffic signals and controls.
- 2.* Installs and repairs electrical wiring, lighting, and equipment.
3. Keeps records and makes reports.
- 4.* Enforces and complies with all applicable safety standards and procedures.
5. Keeps accurate records and may supervise the work of others.

*Essential Functions

Minimum Qualifications:

1. Considerable knowledge of trade practices, methods, tools, and equipment.
2. Working knowledge of electrical motors and signal and alarm systems.
3. Working knowledge of occupational hazards and safe work practices.
4. Ability to make electrical repairs to motors and equipment.
5. Ability to understand and follow oral or written instructions and the ability to comprehend blueprints, shop drawings, or sketches, and to work from these drawings.
6. Ability to keep accurate records and make reports.
7. Must possess a Journeyman's Electrician License.
8. Previous electrical experience, including experience in the repair and maintenance of motors and controls.
9. Must possess a valid Wisconsin Motor Vehicle Operator's License.
10. Must have Commercial Driver's License (CDL) and appropriate endorsements upon

hire or attain same by completion of probationary period.
