

### **GREETERS:**

- Volunteer position asking for 2 or more hours on November 6th (Polls open 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.)
- Times available at all 16 polling locations
- Doesn't have to live in the City limits
- Will be helping people get in the right line and checking the Ward Locator to make sure they are in the right building
- Must come into the City Clerk's Office to fill out volunteer forms
- Deadline to sign up to be a Volunteer Greeter is Friday, October 19th

### **POLLWORKERS:**

- Must come into City Clerk's office to fill out poll worker application
- Must live within the City's limits
- Must attend a 2 hour training session
- Must be able to sit for long periods of time/good hearing/good vision and detail orientated
- When working as a poll worker, you have to be politically neutral when speaking with voters and/or co-workers
- Full day option – 6:30 a.m. to approximately 10:30 p.m. - \$100
- ½ day options:
  - 6:30 a.m. to approximately 2:30 p.m. - \$50
  - 2:30 p.m. to approximately 10:30 p.m. - \$50

### **IN PERSON ABSENTEE BALLOTING:**

Casting an absentee ballot **in person** starts on Monday, October 22<sup>nd</sup> in the City Clerk's Office, 828 Center Ave. between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. The last day to cast an absentee ballot **in person** is Friday, November 2<sup>nd</sup> by 5 p.m. You must be a registered voter in order to cast an absentee ballot.

### **REQUEST FOR RECEIVING AN ABSENTEE BALLOT BY MAIL:**

You must be registered to vote to receive an absentee ballot in the mail

Request must be put in writing or via email stating the following:

My name is \_\_\_\_\_

I am registered to vote at (home address \_\_\_\_\_)

(If you will not be at your home address to receive the ballot ie: college, vacation, etc. you must give us the address you want the ballot mailed to)

Please send me an absentee ballot for the November 6<sup>th</sup> Election.

You must sign first and last name (not Mr. and Mrs. Smith).

The request must also be dated.

We must receive the request no later than Nov. 1<sup>st</sup> – this is the last day that the law allows us to mail out absentee ballots.
