4. NOTES

PURPOSE: To promote facade renovation of historic buildings, to conserve valuable architecture and to preserve the City's ethnic and cultural heritage as reflected in its historic structures.

ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible a building must be in the Harbor Centre Master Plan Phase Two area or in the South 12th Street Heritage Square area. The Historic Preservation Commission or the Architectural Review Board must designate the building as architecturally or historically significant.

GRANT REQUIREMENTS: The design must be prepared by a design professional and must reflect the original design, materials and character of the building. It must be approved by designated agencies.

LABOR STANDARDS: The Applicant, if awarded a construction grant through this program, shall comply with and assure compliance of all Project contractors and subcontractors with the Davis Bacon Act, as amended 40 U.S.C. 276a-276a-5, the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, 40 U.S.C. 327-333, applicable Federal laws, provide weekly payroll reports for contractors/subcontractors working on this project, and other regulations pertaining to labor standards.

CITY PARTICIPATION: The City will grant up to 25% of the completed façade construction project, or 30% if the project meets the Secretary of Interior Standards for Rehabilitation and project is at least \$100,000. Grant funds **will not** be disbursed until all Federal Labor Standards and other requirements are fulfilled.

COMPLETION: To receive the grant, construction work shall begin within 6 months of acceptance of the grant application by the Redevelopment Authority and be completed within 12 months.
