




City of Sheboygan Shoreline Recreational Fire Rings

The City of Sheboygan has provided 7 recreational fire rings along the shoreline of Lake Michigan for public use. These fire rings are available for use without permit or fee and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Please enjoy these fire rings responsibly and clean up all debris and litter after their use.



Fire Ring use is subject to the following rules:

- Users must burn only dry, clean fire wood without paint, plastics, flammable or combustible liquids, rubber, leather, nails, etc.
- The use of flammable liquids to ignite fires is strictly prohibited.
- The height of the wood fuel load shall be no greater than 18 inches.
- Fire must be under constant supervision.
- Use of the fire pits must end by 10:00 p.m. consistent with the use of City Parks.
- The possession of fermented malt beverages or intoxicating liquors is prohibited on all beach areas in the City of Sheboygan.
- The City of Sheboygan is not responsible for any injuries or death as a result of improper use of the fire pits.
