Call to order – The first meeting of the 2011-12 Public Protection & Safety Committee
The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Co-Chairperson Montemayor.

Approval of the minutes of the Public Protection and Safety Committee meeting from
December 15, 2010. Alderperson Dekker moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson
Heidemann. All aye – motion passed.

1. **R. O. No. 53-10-11 (18-31)** submitting a communication from James Kroscher requesting removal of stop signs at three locations in the city. Ryan Sazama stated he would like to gather data from the city with reference to accidents. He stated he will get together with Mr. Kroscher at his house to discuss. Alderperson Heidemann moved to hold. Seconded by Alderperson Sampson. All ayes, motion passed.

2. **R. O. No. 340-10-11 (18-34)** submitting a communication from Susie Runaas, Community Education Lead Specialist, requesting permission to host their annual St. Nicholas Hospital Freedom Run on Monday July 4, 2011.

3. **R.O. No. 350-10-11 (19-7)** submitting a request from St. Nicholas Hospital to sponsor their annual St. Nicholas Hospital Freedom Run on Monday, July 4, 2011 at 7:00 a.m.

Alderperson Sampson moved to file R.O. 18-34 and R. O. 19-7. Alderperson Heidemann seconded. All ayes, motion passed

4. **R. O. No. 341-10-11 (18-35)** submitting a communication from Kristine Krenz, Service Committee Chairperson, requesting permission to post signage at the Indiana Aven./8th St. rotary planting area. Discussion was made with Ryan Sazama with reference to needing more information as to size of signage and how many and where they would like them to be placed. Alderperson Heidemann moved to hold. Alderperson Dekker seconded. All ayes, motion passed.

5. **R. O. No. 343-10-11 (18-37)** submitting the State of WI contract Pricing for the purchase of police duty vehicles for the Sheboygan Police Department.

6. **R. O. No. 194-10-11 (18-48)** by Alderperson Rindfleisch a resolution authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into contract for the purchase of (6) Police Department patrol duty sedans, and (1) Police Department C.I.D. duty sedan utilizing the State of WI Contract.

Alderperson Dekker moved to accept and file R.O. 18-37 and R.O. 18-48 and approve the resolution. Alderperson Sampson seconded. All ayes, motion passed.

7. **Gen. Ord. No. 46-10-11 (18-55)** by Alderpersons Montemayor, Sampson & Versey an ordinance creating Section 18-47 of the Municipal Code so as to place restrictions on dangerous and vicious dogs, amending Section 18-3 of the Municipal Code so as to establish and increase certain penalties for violations of animal ordinances in the City, and repealing and recreating Section 18-46 so as to modify the city's "Leash Law."

Alderperson Dekker moved to forward this to council with a favorable recommendation. Alderperson Sampson seconded. All ayes, motion passed.

8. **R.O. No. 351-10-11 (19-8)** submitting a communication from Susan Patterson of Al & Al's Stein Haus, requesting permission to hold a celebration for their 50th year in business on Saturday, February 19th, 2011 and making various requests of the city.

Alderperson Sampson moved to approve to sell/consume alcohol on the city right of way. Alderperson Heidemann seconded. All ayes, motion passed.

9. **R.O. No. 317-10-11 (17-26)** submitting a letter requesting a waiver of the Sex Offender residency regulations from Nicole Johnson, agent for Christy Groh.
