The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Introduction of committee members, staff and guests.

A motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held January 12, 2010 was made by Ald. Surek and seconded by Ald. Vue. **All ayes; motion approved.**

R.O. No. 352-09-10 (18-45) – Various License Applications: Bev. Op. Lic. App. No. 2630 (Andrew J. Likas)

Submitting various license applications for the period ending June 30, 2010 and June 30, 2011.

Andrew J. Likas failed to appear before the committee. Ald. Surek moved, seconded by Ald. Vue, to deny the license application based upon Mr. Likas' failure to accurately reveal all relevant convictions on his application, his status as a habitual law violator, and his failure to cooperate with the committee. **All ayes; motion approved.**
