## MINUTES

Call to order – The second meeting of the 2011-12 Public Protection & Safety Committee  
The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chairperson Kittelson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Introduction of Committee Members

Approval of the minutes of the Public Protection and Safety Committee meeting from January 12, 2011. Alderperson Montemayor moved to approve, seconded by Alderperson Heidemann. All ayes – motion passed.

- 1. Com. No. 58-10-11 (20-21)** submitting a communication from Edward and Amy Netzer, 2109 N. 19<sup>th</sup> St., re. that parking on both sides of the street be changed so that December 1 thru April 1 there is parking only on one side of the street. A discussion took place with regard to working with DPW to try to clear the excessive snow from the street. Mr. Netzer will contact DPW and make arrangements to have someone come and remove snow from the street to make it easier to travel on. Motion was made by Alderperson Sampson to file the RO, seconded by Alderperson Montemayor. All ayes, motion passed.
