

# PUBLIC PROTECTION AND SAFETY COMMITTEE

## AMENDED MINUTES

**DATE:** Wednesday, January 27, 2010

**TIME:** 5:00 p.m.

Call to order – The second meeting of the 2010-11 Public Protection & Safety Committee. The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chairman Hanna.

Pledge of Allegiance

1. **Gen. Ord. No. 41-09-10 (17-68)** by Alderpersons Hanna, Rindfleisch, Wangemann, Bowers & Surek for action. An ordinance amending portions of Chapter 26 of the Municipal Code relating to establishment of new fees for licenses and permits issued by the Building Inspection Division of the City of Sheboygan. A motion was made to file by Alderperson Wangemann, seconded by Alderperson Bowers. All ayes, motion passed.
2. **Gen. Ord. No. 42-09-10 (17-69)** by Alderpersons Hanna, Rindfleisch, Wangemann, Bowers & Surek for action. An ordinance establishing Article XI of Chapter 26 in the Sheboygan Municipal Code creating a Residential Rental Inspection Program. A motion was made to file by Alderperson Wangemann, seconded by Alderperson Bowers. All ayes, motion passed.
3. **Gen. Ord. No. 43-09-10 (17-71)** by Alderpersons Hanna, Rindfleisch, Wangemann, Bowers & Surek for action. An ordinance amending the text of the City of Sheboygan Official Zoning Ordinance in Section 15.702 so as to increase the permit fee for a driveway permit from \$35.00 to \$50.00 A motion was made to file by Alderperson Wangemann, seconded by Alderperson Bowers. All ayes, motion passed.
4. **Gen. Ord. No. 44-09-10 (17-70)** by Alderpersons Hanna, Rindfleisch, Wangemann, Bowers & Surek for action. An ordinance amending portions of Chapter 26 of the Municipal Code relating to establishment of new fees for licenses and permits issued by the Building Inspection Division of the City of Sheboygan. A motion was made to file by Alderperson Wangemann, seconded by Alderperson Bowers. All ayes, motion passed.
5. **Gen. Ord. No. 53-09-10 (20-73)** by Alderperson Hanna. An ordinance repealing and re-creating Article VI Division 3 of Chapter 50 of the Municipal Code, entitled "Smoke Detectors" so as to update the smoke detector ordinance, including definitions, require specific types of smoke alarms and. Attorney Adams stated that there were a few changes in this document, a copy which is attached. A presentation was made by the city of Sheboygan Fire Inspector with reference to this new smoke detector ordinance. A motion to approve the substitute document made by Alderperson Bowers, seconded by Alderperson Wangemann. All ayes, motion passed.

6. **Gen. Ord. No. 54-09-10 (20-74)** by Alderperson Hanna. An ordinance repealing and re-creating Section 50-47 of the Municipal Code, entitled "Inspections Authorized" so as to adopt the local option contained in Comm 14.01(11)(b)6, Wisconsin Administrative Code, to reduce the number of required fire code inspections to one per calendar year, so long as the interval between those inspections does not exceed 15 months. A motion was made to approve by Alderperson Bowers, seconded by Alderperson Wangemann. All ayes, motion passed.
13. **R.O. No. 380-09-10 (20-22)** by City Clerk Submitting a communication from Chase Longmiller, President of Sheboygan Firefighters Local 483, regarding his concerns with the continued staffing issues that are facing the Sheboygan Fire Department. Chase Longmiller, President of the Sheboygan Firefighters Local 483, made a presentation to the council with regard to the staff of the fire department being below the state average for a town this size. A motion was made to file Alderperson Wangemann, seconded by Alderperson Bowers. All ayes, motion passed.
7. **R. C. No. 395-09-10 (20-57)** by Finance. Your Committee to whom was referred Gen. Ord. No. 44-09-10 by Alderpersons Hanna, Rindfleisch, Wangemann, Bowers and Surek amending portions of Chapter 138-12 of the Municipal Code relating to establishment of new fees for weighing or measuring device licenses issued by the Building Inspection Division of the City of Sheboygan; recommends that the Ordinance be passed. A motion was made to accept and adopt by Alderperson Wangemann, seconded by Alderperson Bowers. All ayes, motion passed.
8. **Res. No. 176-09-10 (20-46)** by Alderperson Hanna. A RESOLUTION authorizing the proper City officials to execute a contract with the State of Wisconsin to provide Weights and Measures inspections for the period of January 2, 2010 through June 30, 2010. A presentation was made by Jack Van Der Weele of the Building Inspection Department with reference to the monies that were made and the cost of having the state take over the duties of weights and measures. A motion was made to accept and adopt by Alderperson Wangemann, seconded by Alderperson Bowers. All ayes, motion passed.
9. **Res. No. 177-09-10 (20-47)** by Alderperson Hanna. A RESOLUTION authorizing the proper City officials to execute a contract with the State of Wisconsin to provide Weights and Measures inspections for the period of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. A motion was made to accept and adopt by Alderperson Wangemann, seconded by Alderperson Bowers. All ayes, motion passed.
