## MINUTES

Call to order – The eighteenth meeting of the 2012-13 Public Protection & Safety Committee  
The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chairperson VanAkkeren.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Approval of the minutes of the Public Protection and Safety Committee meeting from  
January 16, 2013. Alderperson Heidemann moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson  
Lessard. Motion passed – all ayes.

1. **Com. No. 13-12-13 (3.1)** submitting a communication from Eric Bollar being an article from the *Sheboygan Press* entitled, “First commitment: Number of first responders dwindling in county communities”. Alderperson Heidemann moved to file. Seconded by Alderperson Lessard. Motion passed – all ayes.
2. **R. O. No. 251-12-13 (3.7)** submitting the report of the Building Inspection Department for the month of December 2012. This was discussed with Item 3, **R. O. No. 252-12-13 (3.8)** below. Chad Pelishek was present to discuss. Alderperson Lessard moved to accept and file. Seconded by Alderperson Heidemann. Motion passed – all ayes.
3. **R. O. No. 252-12-13 (3.8)** submitting the report of the Building Inspection Department for the year 2012. This was discussed with Item 2, **R. O. No. 251-12-13 (3.7)** above. Motion to accept and file passed 3 – 0.
4. **R. O. No. 264-12-13 (4.9)** submitting a communication from the State of Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services regarding the review of general administrative practices and record keeping for Uniform Dwelling Code (UDC) program (one and two family dwellings) and other UDC construction related issues. Chad Pelishek was present to discuss. Alderperson Heidemann moved to accept and file. Seconded by Alderperson Lessard. Motion passed – all ayes.
5. **R. O. No. 265-12-13 (4.10)** submitting a communication from the State of Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services regarding the review of erosion and sediment control enforcement for uniform dwelling code program (one and two family buildings). Chad Pelishek was present to discuss. Alderperson Heidemann moved to accept and file. Seconded by Alderperson Lessard. Motion passed – all ayes.

No. 268-12-13 (4.13)** submitting a report detailing the bid results for the purchase of (2) 2013 or 2014 Model Jeep Patriot four door, front wheel drive vehicles equipped with fuel efficient drive trains. Motion passed – all ayes.

No. 137-12-13 (5.5)** by Alderperson VanAkkeren authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into contract for the purchase of (2) 2014 Model fuel efficient four to five passenger administrative vehicles for the Sheboygan Police Department. This was discussed with Item 6, **R. O. No. 268-12-13 (4.13)** above. Motion to approve passed 3 – 0.

No. 269-12-13 (7.2)** submitting a communication from the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections requesting a waiver of the Sex Offender Residency restrictions on behalf of State inmate Christopher Holmes to move to either 1123 N. 14<sup>th</sup> St., 1125 N. 14<sup>th</sup>, or 930A Michigan Ave., all transitional living facilities, depending on availability. Josh Butzen was present for the Department of Corrections. Alderperson Heidemann moved to place at the TLP. Seconded by Alderperson VanAkkeren. Motion passed 2 (Heidemann, VanAkkeren) to 1 (Lessard).
9. **R. O. No. 247-12-13 (3.2)** submitting a communication from Holly Rick requesting a waiver of the Sex Offender Residency restrictions on behalf of Wydell Vaughn to move to 930A Michigan Ave., a transitional living facility. Chairperson VanAkkeren advised that this request has been withdrawn. Alderperson Heidemann moved to file. Seconded by Alderperson VanAkkeren. Motion passed – all ayes.
10. **R. O. No. 248-12-13 (3.3)** submitting a communication from Kevin R. Hartl requesting a waiver to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions to live at 1427 N. 10<sup>th</sup> St. Kevin Hartl was present. Alderperson Lessard moved to deny. Seconded by Alderperson Heidemann. Motion passed – all ayes.
11. **R. O. No. 249-12-13 (3.4)** submitting a communication from the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections requesting a waiver of the Sex Offender Residency restrictions on behalf of Bee Her to move to either 1123 N. 14<sup>th</sup> St., 1125 N. 14<sup>th</sup>, or 930A Michigan Ave., all transitional living facilities, based on availability. Mike Roehl was present for the Department of Corrections. Alderperson Heidemann moved to put him (Bee Her) at the TLP. Seconded by Alderperson VanAkkeren. Motion passed 2 (Heidemann, VanAkkeren) to 1 (Lessard).
12. **R. O. No. 250-12-13 (3.5)** submitting a communication from Scott Steinberg requesting a waiver to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions to live at 712 Broughton Dr., Apt. 21. Scott Steinberg did not appear. Alderperson Heidemann moved to deny. Seconded by Alderperson Lessard. Motion passed – all ayes.
13. **R. O. No. 266-12-13 (4.11)** submitting a communication from Donald Paul Savinski requesting a waiver to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions. He wishes to discuss

where he will live in person. Donald Savinski was present. Alderperson Lessard moved to file. Seconded by Alderperson Heidemann. Motion passed – all ayes.

14. **R. O. No. 267-12-13 (4.12)** submitting a communication from Scott Deibert requesting a waiver to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions to live at 1813 S. 11<sup>th</sup> St. Scott Deibert was present. Alderperson Heidemann moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson VanAkkeren. Motion passed 2 (Heidemann, VanAkkeren) to 1 (Lessard).
