Call to order – The twentieth meeting of the 2010-11 Public Protection & Safety Committee. The meeting was called to order at 5 p.m. by Alderperson Kittelson.

Approval of minutes from February 16, 2011, meeting.

Introduction of Committee Members and Guests

- 1. Com. No. 62-10-11 (22-20)** submitting a communication from Teresa Sizonen stating that she and her husband and neighbors are having trouble with another neighbor regarding the use of an unfinished alley behind N. 20th St. near the Kwik Trip. Mr. Sizonen and neighbors work together to keep the alley clear. Per ADA Adams, the one neighbor using it when it's soft isn't doing anything illegal. Alleys are not maintained by the City. The situation is a neighbor problem. Motion made by Alderman Dekker to file, seconded by Alderman Sampson. All ayes.
- 2. Gen. Ord. No. 52-10-11 (22-49)** by Alderperson Kittelson, an ordinance relating to No Parking, Stopping, Standing so as to change the parking limits on the east and west sides of S. 12th Place. Parking issues with South High students are causing a problem. Motion to approve made by Alderman Montemayor, seconded by Alderman Heidemann. All ayes.
- 3. Res. No. 219-10-11 (22-37)** by Alderperson Kittelson, a RESOLUTION authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into contract for the purchase of Mobile Data terminals, Ruggedized Laptop Computers and accessories for the Sheboygan Fire Department. Motion to approve made by Alderperson Montemayor, seconded by Alderman Sampson. All ayes.

No. 410-10-11 (22-24)** Submitting a communication from the Harbor Centre BID to request street closures during their annual Harbor Centre Family Day and Bike Race on Thursday, June 23rd in the downtown area in conjunction with GEARGRINDER cycling team. 7. **R. O. No. 418-10-11 (22-28)** Submitting a report relative to the City entering into agreement To purchase (10) New MDT's (Mobile Data Terminals) and (3) Ruggedized portable laptop computers and (10) powered Broadband Modems for the Sheboygan Fire Department and ambulance vehicles. Motion to approve made by Alderman Heidemann, seconded by Alderperson Montemayor. All ayes.
8. **R. O. No. 416-10-11 (22-27)** By the Fire Chief. Submitting the Fourth Quarter 2010 EMS Quality Assurance and Quality Improvement Report (October 1, 2010 – December 31, 2010). Motion to approve made by Alderperson Montemayor, seconded by Alderman Sampson. All ayes.
9. A discussion with regard to On-Street Handicapped parking spaces with reference to the impact of winter parking rules. Steve Gilbert stated keeping handicapped spaces open in the same spot during the winter will be nearly impossible. The streets need to be plowed and trucks may come through several times a night, making it difficult to keep the handicapped spots cleared. If there's no snow on a particular night, perhaps there could be exceptions. There are maybe three or four of these handicapped spots in the city. Handicapped spots will be exempt from winter parking rules. Motion made by Alderperson Dekker, seconded by Alderperson Montemayor to make on street handicapped spots exempt from the winter parking ordinance. All ayes.
10. **R. O. No. 419-10-11 (22-25)** Submitting a request for a waiver of the Sex Offender Restrictions from Tavis Heiberger. David VanAkkeren spoke about concerns neighbors had with Tavis' past. Motion made by Alderperson Montemayor to approve, seconded by Alderman Sampson. All ayes.
