

AMENDED MINUTES
HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

Historic Preservation Commission held a meeting on Thursday, March 4, 2010 at 4:00 P.M. in the Third Floor Conference Room, City Hall. Chairperson Scott Lewandoske chaired the meeting.

Scott Lewandoske called the meeting to order at 4:00 P.M.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Introduction of Commission members and guests.

Introduction of Commission was not held.

Public Input

No public input was received.

Approval of minutes from the December 3, 2009 & January 7, 2010 Public Hearing.

Chairperson Lewandoske asked to amend the minutes of the December 3, 2009 and January 7, 2010 meetings to reflect that Susan Hundley was excused.

Aaron Brault moved, Nancy Moudry seconded to approve the minutes as amended. Motion carries.

Discussion/possible action on landmarking North 12th Street between Superior and Michigan Avenues and the wreck of the Lottie Cooper.

Ald Wangemann stated that a resolution has been passed by the Common Council to protect North 12th Street and that landmarking it would not be a problem.

Chad Pelishek stated his concerns that the Public Works Committee should be contacted about the landmarking of the street for future repairs. Ald. Wangemann said that should be not a concern.

Ald. Wangemann discussed the landmarking of the Lottie Cooper as this structure is a great draw for the City and should be protected.

Ald. Wangemann moved, Nancy Moudry seconded to approve the two sites in the next landmarking process. Motion carries.

Information about last group of buildings to be landmarked and Common Council approval.

Chad Pelishek stated the Common Council had approved the sites as present in the January 7, 2010 Public Hearing. Letters and plaques for sent out to the landmarked properties. No further correspondence has been received.

Discussion and possible action on next group of buildings and letters to be sent out.

Chad Pelishek stated that we would continue down the list and draft letters, but that it may be awhile for this to occur due to current workload.

This item was held to the next meeting.

Discussion on Sheboygan County Local History Expo on May 3, 2010.

Chairperson Lewandoske stated that Sheboygan County will be holding an expo at the Sheboygan County Museum and that they have asked the Commission if they were interested in a display. Chairperson Lewandoske said he was going to prepare a display and planned on attending. Ald. Wangemann said he was on the board and will be there also.

Discussion on Committee members whose terms expire in April: Alderman Wangemann, Jon Dolson, and Roger Lahm.

Chairperson Lewandoske stated that if Commission members are interested in staying on the Commission, they should contact the Mayor's office.

Other topics by committee members to discuss at the next meeting and select date for next meeting.
