

Dear Mr. Graf,

I am the Global Education Coordinator of Lakeshore Technical College, and I am organizing a German Exchange Program for 4 students and 1 faculty this spring to Hessen, Germany. The group will stay with host families, visit companies/farms/cultural sites, and learn about the German culture and school system. They will also participate in job shadow opportunities in their respective fields of study.

For the last seven years, LTC has enjoyed a relationship with Reichspräsident Friedrich-Ebert Schule (RFES) in the city of Kassel where German students come here in the fall and LTC students visit Germany in the spring. This past October, the German students visited Mayor Van Akkeren and learned about the sister city relationship between Sheboygan and Esslingen am Neckar, Germany.

As part of LTC's mission "to enrich lives and strengthen the economy by preparing a work force that is skilled, diverse, and flexible", the Global Education office provides programs, such as the German Exchange Program, that develop critical global skills for students and faculty. In today's increasingly global economy, it is crucial that we equip our students to be ready for the global workforce.



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



Are YOU Global Ready?

Experience 2-3 weeks in Germany in the spring (following May graduation). Travel with your fellow students to Hessen, Germany, stay with a host family, and attend school at Reichspräsident Friedrich-Ebert Schule (RFES).

- Receive global skills required in today's workforce—problem-solving, adaptability, flexibility, communication, self-confidence.
- Receive credit toward your program (for programs that participate in the exchange and require an internship).

Students are required to complete the Applied International Studies course and take one semester of German language classes.

Eligibility*:

Priority given to students enrolled in Business, Wind Energy, Trade & Industry, and Dairy Herd Management.

Pre-Requisite:

- * GPA of 2.5 or higher
- * Able to obtain a valid passport

**Other program students may be accepted depending upon the ability of German partner college to provide related program experiences.*


