4. Discussion and possible action (sending to Council with Committee's recommendation) a resolution lifting the hiring freeze in order to recall a building inspector from layoff in the Department of City Development/Building Inspection, due to a retirement.

Paulette informed the members that due to the upcoming retirement of the Leadman-Plumbing/Heating Inspector on May 5, 2010, that she would like to recall from layoff the Housing/Environmental Inspector. The department could then focus on code inspections, which would bring in more revenue to the City.

Ald. Gischia mentioned that a Fiscal Information Form (FIF) needs to be completed and brought to Council in order to go forward with this process.

A motion was made by Ald. Kath to lift the hiring freeze and recall from layoff the Housing/Environmental Inspector, effective May 2, 2010, at his same rate of pay as when he was placed on layoff. Second by Ald. Kittelson, Passed 4-0.

5. Discussion and possible action Vacant Position Approval Form for the Department of Planning & Development, Housing/Environmental Inspector.
