Call to order – The twenty-second meeting of the 2010-11 Public Protection & Safety Committee
The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chairperson Kittelson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Introduction of Committee Members.

Approval of the minutes of the Public Protection and Safety Committee meeting from March 16, 2011. Alderperson Montemayor moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson Heidemann. All aye – motion passed.

1. **R. O. No. 450-10-11 (24-23)** submitting a communication from Wolf-Olson Post No. 1230 requesting permission to hold their Annual Buddy Poppy Drive on various corners and business places throughout the City on Friday, May 13th from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. and on Saturday, May 14th from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. A motion to file and approve was made by Alderperson Heidemann, seconded by Alderperson Montemayor. All ayes, motion carried.
2. **R.O. No. 448-10-11 (24-25)** submitting a communication from the John Michael Kohler Arts Center making various requests to accommodate their 41st Annual Midsummer Festival of the Arts on July 16 and 17, 2011. A motion was made by Alderperson Montemayor to file the R.O., approve their plans, and recommend they apply for the Street Festival permit, seconded by Alderperson Dekker. All ayes, motion carried.
3. **Gen. Ord. No. 53-10-11 (23-40)** by Alderperson Dekker an ordinance repealing and recreating §118-242 and §42-104 of the Sheboygan Municipal Code so as to exempt vehicles legally parked in on-street handicapped parking zones from the winter parking and snow emergency rules. A motion was made to send to council with a favorable recommendation with the exception of snow emergency, with the stipulation that this be reviewed in one year was made by Alderperson Dekker, seconded by Alderperson Heidemann. A discussion took place with reference to the ordinance. It was requested that Steve Gilbertson contact Ms. Shaw with the results of the committee's decision. Three ayes, two nays, motion carried.

4. **Gen. Ord. No. 55-10-11 (24-48)** by Alderperson Kittelson an ordinance relating to parking so as to add 2-hour parking limits on the east side of S. 8th Street north of Wilson Ave. A motion was made to recommend to council with a favorable recommendation was made by Alderperson Heidemann, seconded by Alderperson Montemayor. All ayes, motion carried.
5. **R. O. No. 242-10-11 (24-55)** by Alderperson Kittelson a resolution authorizing entering into an agreement between the City of Sheboygan and Gregg Lindner, for the purpose of permitting the Police Department's Emergency Response Team to use property at 2901 Calumet Drive for SWAT practice. A motion was made by Alderperson Montemayor, seconded by Alderperson Heidemann to recommend the resolution be adopted. All ayes, motion carried.
6. **R. O. No. 451-10-11 (24-28)** Submitting a request for a waiver to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions from Brandon Schweisthal. A motion was made to approve by Alderperson Montemayor, seconded by Alderperson Dekker. All ayes, motion carried.
7. **R. O. No. 452-10-11 (24-29)** Submitting a request for a waiver relating to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions for Christopher Malwitz. A motion was made to approve by Alderperson Dekker, seconded by Alderperson Sampson. All ayes, motion carried.
9. **R. O. No. 453-10-11 (24-30)** Submitting a request for a waiver from the Sex Offender Residency restrictions from Timothy G. Grande. A motion was made to approve by Alderperson Montemayor, seconded by Alderperson Kittelson. Three ayes, 2 nays, motion carried.
10. **R. O. No. 454-10-11 (24-52)** Submitting a communication from Wydell J. Vaughn requesting a waiver of the Sex Offender Residence Restrictions. A motion was made by Alderperson Dekker, seconded by Alderperson Heidemann to deny this request. All ayes, motion carried.
