Call to order – The first meeting of the 2013-14 Public Protection & Safety Committee
The meeting was called to order at 5:05 p.m. by Chairperson Carlson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Approval of the minutes of the Public Protection and Safety Committee meeting from
April 10, 2013. Alderperson VanAkkeren moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson Versey.
Motion passed – all ayes.

1. **R. O. No. 337-12-13 (4.1)** from Depot Auto Service & Towing Co., Inc., requesting that the City switch to a rotation system for towing services using a list of towing companies within the jurisdiction of the governing law enforcement agency. Chairperson Carlson advised that he got a request from the Chief to hold this until the next meeting. Chairperson Carlson contacted Depot and Bret's to inform them. Alderperson Versey moved to hold. Seconded by Alderperson VanAkkeren. Motion passed – all ayes.
2. **R. O. No. 338-12-13 (4.5)** from Jason LaGow requesting that the deaf child area signs at his old home in the 1300 block of Union Ave. be moved to his new home at 2501 N. 6th St. in order to help his special needs child. Ryan Sazama recommended the signs be installed and advised he will draft an ordinance. Assistant City Attorney Adams advised that it will be two ordinances. Alderperson Versey moved to recommend the ordinances be drafted. Seconded by Alderperson VanAkkeren. Motion passed – all ayes.
3. **Gen. Ord. No. 64-12-13 (7.3)** by Alderpersons Lessard, Carlson, Van Akkeren and Heidemann repealing and recreating Subsection 26-1008(i) of the Municipal Code relating to clearwater compliance inspection fees so as to provide for a waiver of the fee under certain circumstances. Scott Winter was present from the Building Inspection Department. He suggested that marriage should be added to the applicable circumstances. Alderperson VanAkkeren moved to amend the document to include marriages in which one party is already occupying the residence. Seconded by Alderperson Versey. ACA Adams suggested the motion include to amend the ordinance to provide that in (i) (2) a add the word "marriage" between "death" and "or". Alderperson VanAkkeren agreed. Seconded by Alderperson Versey. Motion passed – all ayes. Alderperson VanAkkeren moved to approve the ordinance as amended. Seconded by Alderperson Versey. Motion passed – all ayes.

4. **R. O. No. 339-12-13 (9.1)** submitting the report of the Building Inspection Department for the month of March 2013. Traci Hermann was present from the Building Inspection Department. Alderperson VanAkkeren moved to accept and file. Seconded by Alderperson Versey. Motion passed – all ayes.
5. **R. O. No. 340-12-13 (9.2)** submitting a communication from James Turner requesting a waiver to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions to live at 1213 N. 12th St. James Turner was present. After discussion, Alderperson VanAkkeren moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson Versey. Motion passed – all ayes.
