

**MINUTES**  
**COMMITTEE ON LAW & LICENSING**

**April 27, 2010 - 5:00 p.m.**

Chairperson Rindfleisch called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Introduction of committee members, staff and guests.

A motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held April 13, 2010 was made by Ald. VanderWeele and seconded by Ald. Kath. **All ayes; motion approved.**

**Presentation to the Committee by Assistant City Attorney Charles C. Adams**

ACA Adams discussed the general duties of the committee and the various types of licenses the committee will be dealing with.

**R.C. No. 508-09-10 (26-52) [see also R.O. No. 491-09-10 (25-86)] – Various License Applications: Alc. Bev. Lic. App. No. 2717-Shevegas (Toby Watson, Agent); Bev. Op. Lic. App. No. 8538 (Nicole M. Schneider); Taxicab Op. Lic. App. Nos. 8547 (Megan M. Davis) and 8546 (Dorris M. Frei)**

Submitting various license applications for the period ending June 30, 2010 and June 30, 2011.

Toby Watson appeared before the committee to discuss his application. After discussion of his record and his failure to include a violation on his application, Ald. Bowers moved, seconded by Ald. Wangemann, to grant the license with a warning to include all relevant information on future applications. **All ayes; motion approved.**

Nicole Schneider failed to appear before the committee. Ald. Wangemann moved, seconded by Ald. VanderWeele, to request via certified mailing Ms. Schneider's appearance before the committee at its May 11th meeting. **All ayes; motion approved.**

Megan Davis failed to appear before the committee. Ald. VanderWeele moved, seconded by Ald. Kath, to request via certified mailing Ms. Davis' appearance before the committee at its May 11th meeting. **All ayes; motion approved.**

Dorris M. Frei failed to appear before the committee, but had telephoned Ald. Rindfleisch and indicated that she was unable to attend. Ald. Bowers moved, seconded by Ald. Wangemann, to request via regular mail Ms. Frei's appearance before the committee at its May 11th meeting. **All ayes; motion approved.**

**Possible action regarding Alc. Bev. Lic. No. 2526-Pier 57 Deli & Lounge (Pam Behnke, Agent)**

Pam Behnke appeared before the committee and explained that she intends to stay open year-round in the future, but did have irregular hours over the winter and had been closed for several months because of painting that was being done. No action by the committee is necessary.

**Possible action regarding Bev. Op. Lic. No. 8215 (Christopher A. Theune) and Alc. Bev. Lic. No. 2720-Rehab (Rufino C. Martinez, Jr.)**

Christopher Theune failed to appear before the committee.

Rufino C. Martinez, Jr. appeared before the committee and indicated that Shenanigans is still open at this time because Mr. Martinez does not close on the property until May 3, 2010. He indicated that Christopher Theune will not be employed as a bartender by Rehab.

Ald. Wangemann moved, seconded by Ald. VanderWeele, to request via certified mailing Mr. Theune's appearance before the committee at its May 11th meeting, and to take no action against Rehab or Rufino C. Martinez, Jr. **All ayes; motion approved.**
