Call to order – The first meeting of the 2011-12 Public Protection & Safety Committee
The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chairperson Kittelson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Introduction of Committee Members and Guests

Chairman's opening comments and discussion regarding committee policies, procedures, and protocol. Chairperson Kittelson provided written procedures to the members.

Approval of the minutes of the Public Protection and Safety Committee meeting from April 13, 2011. Alderperson Dekker moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson Sampson. All aye – motion passed.

1. **R. O. No. 485-10-11 (26-14)** from Fr. Michael Dineen, Event Coordinator, Sheboygan Catholic Schools Annual Unity Walk/Run, requesting permission to hold a two mile walk on Sunday, May 22, 2011, to be held within the South Pier District around the Blue Harbor facility. Assistant City Attorney Adams advised the committee does not have to approve anything. The group needs a parade permit, which goes through the police department. Alderperson Dekker moved to file. Seconded by Alderperson Sampson. All aye – motion passed.
2. **R. O. No. 488-10-11 (26-17)** from Mark Mand, President of the Sheboygan Liars Dice Club, requesting permission to hold their annual Liars Club of Sheboygan Annual Street Dance on Sunday, August 7, 2011. ACA Adams advised that they need to get a street festival permit, which is through the police department. If they need a change of premises, extension of premises, or picnic permit, that can go through Law and Licensing. Alderperson Dekker moved to file. Seconded by Alderperson Sampson. All aye – motion passed.
3. **R. O. No. 489-10-11 (26-18)** from Susie Patterson, Al & Al's Stein Haus & the Tavern, requesting permission to close S. 12th St. from Clara Ave. to the end of their building, and Clara Ave. from the S. 12th St. intersection to the end of their building for their 4th Annual Heritage Square Oktoberfest on Friday, September 30th, Saturday, October 1st, and Sunday, October 2nd. ACA Adams advised she needs a street festival permit. Alderperson Dekker moved to file. Seconded by Alderperson Sampson. All aye – motion passed.

5. **R. O. No. 487-10-11 (26-16)** from Terry Blevons filing an appeal to the Sexual Offender Residency restrictions. Terry Blevons was present and explained his request to reside at 3615 S. Business Drive, where he has been living for approximately 15 months. After discussion, Alderperson Dekker moved to deny. Motion to deny failed for lack of a second. Alderperson Kittelson moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson Sampson. Motion failed 2 (Kittelson, Sampson) to 2 (Carlson, Dekker.) Alderperson Kittelson advised Mr. Blevons to appear at the May 11th meeting in front of the full committee.
4. **R. O. No. 486-10-11 (26-15)** from Wydell Vaughn filing an appeal to the Sexual Offender Residency restrictions. Mr. Vaughn was not present. Alderperson Sampson moved to deny. Seconded by Alderperson Dekker. All aye – motion passed.
