Chairperson Rindfleisch called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Introduction of committee members, staff and guests.

A motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held April 27, 2010 was made by Ald. VanderWeele and seconded by Ald. Kath. **Four ayes and no nays; motion approved.**

Adoption of the rules and policies of the Law & Licensing Committee
