

# PUBLIC PROTECTION AND SAFETY COMMITTEE

## MINUTES

**DATE:** Wednesday, May 11, 2011

**TIME:** 5:00 p.m.

**MEMBERS PRESENT:** Alderpersons Kittelson, Dekker, Sampson, VanAkkeren and Carlson

Call to order – The second meeting of the 2011-12 Public Protection & Safety Committee  
The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chairperson Kittelson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Introduction of Committee Members and Guests

Approval of the minutes of the Public Protection and Safety Committee meeting from April 27, 2011. Alderperson Dekker moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson Sampson. All aye – motion passed.

- 1. R. O. No. 13-11-12 (3-15)** Submitting a communication from Christopher Domagalski, Chief of Police, stating that the Sheboygan Jaycees has approached him regarding expanding the hours for beer sales during the 2011 Brat Days and stating that the Police Department will not oppose the request if the Common Council wishes to grant the request.
- 2. R. O. No. 14-11-12 (3-42)** Submitting a communication from the Sheboygan Jaycees requesting the review and approval of the operating hours for their annual Brat Day's festival at Kiwanis Park from August 4-6, 2011.

R. O. No. 13-11-12 (3-15) and R. O. No. 14-11-12 (3-42) – both of these R. O. were decided upon together. A motion was made to file both by Alderperson Sampson. Seconded by Alderperson Dekker. All aye – motion carried.

- 3. R. O. No. 10-11-12 (3-16)** Submitting a communication from Jane Hanson requesting pedestrian crosswalks painted at the corner of Lakeshore Dr. and High Ave.

A motion was made to approve the painting of crosswalks with temporary signs indicating a crosswalk is ahead by Alderperson VanAkkeren, seconded by Alderperson Carlson. All aye – motion carried.

4. **R. O. No. 11-11-12 (3-17)** Submitting a communication from Dr. Knowles of Knowles Chiropractic requesting permission to close a small section of road in front of their office at 1509 N. 13<sup>th</sup> St. for a patient/neighborhood appreciation event on June 24<sup>th</sup>.

A motion to file made by Alderperson Sampson, seconded by Alderperson Carlson. All aye – motion carried.

5. **Res. No. 6-11-12 (3-32)** By Alderperson Kittelson. A resolution authorizing the appropriate City officials to enter into agreement with the Sheboygan Area School District relative to providing the public school system with school liaison officers

A motion to approve the agreement was made by Alderperson VanAkkeren, seconded by Alderperson Dekker. All aye – motion carried.

7. **R. O. No. 15-11-12 (3-44)** Submitting a communication from Denny Moyer, General Manager of the Sheboygan Athletic Club requesting permission to close Wildwood Ave. on Saturday, June 4, to celebrate the completion this phase of the park renovation project and to also place barricades in the middle of Wildwood Ave. just south of the VFW Hall.

A motion was made to file by Alderperson Carlson, seconded by Alderperson Dekker. All aye – motion carried.

8. **R. O. No. 16-11-12 (3-46)** Submitting a communication from the John Michael Kohler Arts Center making various requests of the City to hold their annual Art Armada on July 4<sup>th</sup>.

A motion was made to file by Alderperson Carlson, seconded by Alderperson Dekker. All aye – motion carried.

6. **Gen. Ord. No. 5-11-12 (3-36)** By Alderperson Dekker. An ordinance repealing and recreating Section 70-265 of the Municipal Code relating to appeals of the 2000 foot requirement of the sex offender residency restrictions, so as to provide for the common council to decide the appeal.

A long discussion took place. A motion was made to approve by Alderperson Van Akkeren, seconded by Alderperson Dekker. Three (3) ayes, two nays, motion carried.

9. **R. O. No. 487-10-11 (26-16)** from Terry Blevons filing an appeal to the Sexual Offender Residency restrictions. Terry Blevons was present and explained his request to reside at 3615 S. Business Drive, where he has been living for approximately 15 months. After discussion, Alderperson Dekker moved to deny. Motion to deny failed for lack of a second. Alderperson Kittelson moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson Sampson. Motion failed 2 (Kittelson, Sampson) to 2 (Carlson, Dekker.) Alderperson Kittelson advised Mr. Blevons to appear at the May 11<sup>th</sup> meeting in front of the full committee.

A motion was made to approve by Alderperson Sampson, seconded by Chairperson Kittelson. Three (3) ayes, two (2) nays, motion carried.

10. **R. O. No. 12-11-12 (3-47)** Submitting a communication from Danny Beeman requesting a waiver of the Sex Offender Residency regulations.

A motion was made to approve by Alderperson Dekker, seconded by Alderperson VanAkkeren. All aye – motion carried.
