## MINUTES

Call to order – The sixth meeting of the 2011-12 Public Protection & Safety Committee  
The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chairperson Kittelson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Approval of the minutes of the Public Protection and Safety Committee meeting from June 29, 2011. Alderperson Sampson moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson VanAkkeren. All ayes – motion passed.

1. **R. O. No. 100-11-12 (7-11)** submitting a communication from Angela Ramos stating her concerns with the serious non-compliance with vehicles not recognizing pedestrians and the unsafe crosswalk at the intersection of S. 14<sup>th</sup> St. and Illinois Ave. Alderperson Kittelson stated that she went to speak with Angela Ramos and discussed her options for the safety of her family. She stated that there really wasn't much that could be done with regard to the corner of 14<sup>th</sup> and Illinois Avenue as there is a stop light a block away that can be utilized for the safety of pedestrians. A motion to file was made by Alderperson Sampson, seconded by Alderperson Carlson. All ayes, motion carried.
2. **R. O. No. 41-11-12 (7-21)** by Alderperson Kittelson a resolution authorizing application for 2011 Justice Assistance Grant Program Award (Local Solicitation) and entering into Memorandum of understanding with Sheboygan County. A motion to approve was made by Alderperson VanAkkeren, seconded by Alderperson Carlson. All ayes, motion carried.
3. **Gen. Ord. No. 17-11-12 (7-35)** by Alderperson Kittelson an ordinance repealing and recreating Section 26-37(a)(2)(b) of the Municipal Code and creating Section 26-651(e) of the Municipal Code so as to modify various portions of the adopted model codes so as to reinstate certain provisions formerly contained in the Municipal Code prior to adoption of model codes so as reflect the specific needs and conditions of the City of Sheboygan. A motion was made to recommend approval was made by Alderperson Sampson, seconded by Alderperson Carlson. All ayes, motion carried.
4. The Sheboygan Firefighters Local 483 would like to obtain permission for the 2011 Fill the Boot MDA fundraiser. A motion was made to approve for the city right of way by Alderperson Sampson, seconded by Alderperson Carlson. All ayes, motion carried.
