MINUTES

Call to order – The 6th meeting of the 2010-11 Public Protection & Safety Committee. The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Alderperson Kittelson.

Pledge of Allegiance

Approval of minutes from June 30, 2010 meeting.

Introduction of Committee Members and Guests

- 1. Com. No. 23-10-11 (6-78)** from Marilyn Cooley requesting that the truck route be changed in the area of the Regency House as there is a noise issue – this area used to be an industrial area but is now residential. Marilyn Cooley believed it was a safety issue as well as a noise issue. She suggested diverting traffic to a different route. Ryan stated the truck route is mainly for the post office. Ryan will ask the post office to take an alternate route for their smaller trucks. Motion made by Alderman Radtke to file, seconded by Alderman Dekker. All ayes.
- 2. Com. No. 24-10-11 (7-18)** from Signe Jorgenson regarding the hazardous traffic situation at the intersection of High Ave and Lakeshore Dr. Signe spoke of the dangerous situation at the intersection, especially in summer when there is more traffic. Ryan said there may be some ways to clean up this intersection. Motion made to hold made by Alderman Dekker, seconded by Alderman Radtke. All ayes.
- 3. Com. No. 25-10-11 (7-19)** from Donna Reseburg stating that she is still waiting for the crosswalk at the corner of Superior Ave and N 31 St as it was approved during the last Council year. This crosswalk is under construction at this point. Motion made to file made by Alderperson Montemayor, seconded by Alderman Radtke. All ayes.
- 4. Res. No. 52-10-11 (7-47)** by Alderperson Hanna and Bowers granting Camp Evergreen permission to hold their 3 mile benefit walk on the streets of the City of Sheboygan. Motion made to approve by Alderman Radtke, seconded by Alderman Dekker. All ayes.

5. **R.O. No. 108-10-11 (6-70)** from John Thomack requesting a “No Parking Between Signs” posting in front of their loading dock driveway at 3455 Paine Ave. Ryan suggested this document be filed. Motion made to file made by Alderman Radtke, seconded by Alderman Dekker. All ayes.
6. **R.O. No. 131-10-11 (7-22)** from Blaine Werner of the Sheboygan Professional Fire Fighters Local 483 requesting permission to run their annual “Fill the Boot” campaign in conjunction with MDA (Muscular Dystrophy Association) on August 11, 12 and 13. This campaign is run every year. They will be going to four-way intersections to eliminate traffic issues, rather than traffic lights. Motion made to approve made by Alderperson Montemayor, seconded by Alderman Radtke. All ayes.
7. **R. O. No. 132-10-11 (7-24)** from Patricia Aaholm regarding the Sheboygan Firefighters Ambulance issue. Patricia read from a prepared document regarding this matter. Motion made by Alderman Dekker to file, seconded by Alderperson Montemayor. All ayes.
8. **R.O. No. 133-10-11 (7-31)** from Officer Priebe requesting that the following neighborhood be recognized as an official neighborhood watch group and is requesting street signs and window decals: North boundary, Dillingham Ave; East boundary, Lakeshore Dr; South boundary, Ashland Ave, West boundary, S. 8th St. Motion made to file and approve by Alderperson Monteymayor, seconded by Alderman Dekker. All ayes.
9. **R.O. No. 134-10-11 (7-32)** from Alderperson Bohren being a petition with almost 300 signatures from the owner of Fountain Park Family Restaurant located at 922 N 8 St requesting that the 2011 Family Day and Bike Race be relocated to another area. Motion to hold made by Alderman Radtke, seconded by Alderperson Montemayor. All ayes.
10. **R.O. No. 136-10-11 (7-57)** from Oriannah Paul, President of the Sheboygan Liberty Coalition, making the Council aware that they will be holding a one-year anniversary Freedom Rally TEA Party event at Fountain Park in Sheboygan on Saturday, September 4. Oriannah spoke about the event. Motion made by Alderman Dekker to file, seconded by Alderman Radtke. All ayes.
11. **R. O. No. 137-10-11 (7-58)** from Heather Adamson, Director of the “Full Moon Race”, requesting permission to hold their 3rd annual event on August 21, 2010, with the race starting in Plymouth and follows the Old Plank Trail for the majority of the race and ends at Sheboygan’s Memorial Mall. Motion to file made by Alderperson Montemayor, seconded by Alderman Radtke. All ayes.
