Chairperson Rindfleisch called the meeting to order at 5:04 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Introduction of committee members, staff and guests.

Stephanie A. Garcia failed to appear before the committee. Ald. Wangemann moved, seconded by Ald. VanderWeele, to deny the license application based upon Ms. Garcia's failure to accurately reveal all relevant convictions on her application, her record of violations related to the licensed activity, and her failure to cooperate with the committee. **All ayes; motion approved.**

VanderWeele moved, seconded by Ald. Bowers, to grant the license with a warning to include all relevant information on future applications. **All ayes; motion approved.**

A motion was made by Ald. VanderWeele, seconded by Ald. Bowers, to invite the Thai Cafe to apply for one of the two available "Class B" alcohol beverage licenses and to hold open the other available license. **All ayes; motion approved.**
