

# PUBLIC PROTECTION AND SAFETY COMMITTEE

## MINUTES

**DATE:** Wednesday, July 28, 2010

**TIME:** 5:00 p.m.

**PLACE:** Lower Level Training Room, City Hall

**MEMBERS PRESENT:** Alderpersons Kittelson, Montemayor, Heidemann, Radtke and Dekker

Call to order – The seventh meeting of the 2010-11 Public Protection & Safety Committee  
The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chairperson Kittelson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Introduction of Committee Members and Guests

Approval of the minutes of the Public Protection and Safety Committee meeting from July 14, 2010 was held until the next meeting due to the date being incorrect on the agenda.

1. **Com. No. 24-10-11 (7-18)** from Ms. Signe Jorgenson regarding the hazardous traffic situation at the intersection of High Ave. and Lakeshore Dr. Ryan Sazama stated that he checked the area and checked into the accident history in that area from 2007 to present. It was determined that the striping of the area needs to be done and the work is in progress. He will write a letter to Ms. Jorgenson telling her of the recommendation from the results of the meeting. A motion to file was made by Alderperson Montemayor, seconded by Alderperson Radtke. All ayes – motion approved.
2. **Com. No. 30-10-11 (8-25)** from Mike Daniels stating he is upset with the concert noise levels allowed at Kiwanis Park during the festivals which carries for long distances and wants the City to take action for this and all other picnics/festivals. Discussion was held and a motion to file was made by Alderperson Montemayor, seconded by Alderperson Radtke. All ayes – motion approved.
3. **Com. No. 31-10-11 (8-26)** from Dawn Rakow stating her concerns with the fact that people are allowed to set up chairs and blankets and are taping off areas the night before or early the day of parades not allowing anyone else a place to sit. Discussion was made with regard to these concerns. Motion was made to file by Alderperson Dekker, seconded by Alderperson Montemayor. All ayes – motion passed.
4. **Gen. Ord. No. 13-10-11 (8-46)** by Alderperson Kittelson. An Ordinance repealing and re-creating Section 122-14 of the Municipal Code, entitled “Private well abandonment” so as to update the ordinance and bring it into compliance with the requirements of the Wisconsin Administrative Code. ACA Chuck Adams stated that the ordinance needed to be updated to read 5 years instead of 10. A motion was made to approve and send to council with favorable recommendations by Alderperson Montemayor, seconded by Alderperson Radtke. All ayes – motion passed.

6. **R. O. No. 156-10-11 (8-49)** by City Clerk. Submitting a communication from Patricia Aaholm regarding the issue with the SFD/Ambulance and stating that the only proper way to resolve it is to have a public referendum on the November ballot. Patricia Aaholm made a presentation in regard to having a referendum placed on the November ballot. After her presentation a discussion took place and a motion to file the R.O. was made by Alderperson Montemayor, seconded by Alderperson Dekker. All ayes – motion passed.
5. **R. O. No. 62-10-11 (8-37)** by Alderpersons Bowers, Versey, Wangemann and Heidemann. A RESOLUTION calling for a referendum on abandoning the City's fire-based ambulance service. A discussion was made with regard to the information that was presented by Fire Chief Hermann and others. As a result of that discussion, a motion was made to hold the document until more information can be gathered by Alderperson Heidemann, seconded by Alderperson Montemayor. All ayes – motion passed.
7. **R.O. No. 134-10-11 (7-32)** by City Clerk. Submitting a communication from Alderperson Bohren being a petition with almost 300 signatures from the owner of Fountain Park Family Restaurant located at 922 N. 8<sup>th</sup> St. requesting that the 2011 Family Day and Bike Race be relocated to another area. Discussion took place with regard to the communication received from the Fountain Park owner. He was out of town and could not attend the meeting. After discussion on this R.O. a motion was made to file by Alderperson Montemayor, seconded by Alderperson Dekker. All ayes – motion passed.
8. **R.O. No. 152-10-11 (8-27)** by Building Inspection Department. We hereby submit the report of the Building Inspection Department for the month of: JUNE 2010. A motion was made to accept and file the Building Inspection Department report by Alderperson Radtke, seconded by Alderperson Montemayor. All ayes – motion passed.
9. **R.O. No. 153-10-11 (8-29)** by City Clerk. Submitting information from Alderperson Versey regarding the "Requirements of the City of Milwaukee Pit bull and Rottweiler Ordinance." Alderperson Versey presented information and after his presentation a motion was made to hold for the collection of further information and study by Alderperson Dekker, seconded by Alderperson Heidemann. All ayes – motion passed.
10. **R. O. No. 154-10-11 (8-44)** by City Clerk. Submitting a communication from Adam Mendez submitting an application for a waiver of the Sexual Offender Residence restrictions. There was no representation present for Mr. Mendez at the meeting. Therefore, no action was taken. This will be put on the agenda for the next meeting.
11. **R. O. No. 155-10-11 (8-45)** by City Clerk. Submitting a communication from the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections filing an appeal to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions for State inmate Michael Sullivan. A motion to deny was made by Alderperson Heidemann, seconded by Alderperson Radtke. All ayes – motion passed
