1. **R. O. No. 119-11-12 (9-17)** submitting a communication from Menhard Sonnemann questioning whether City representatives are going to nursing homes and asking that they use the Fire Department for non-emergency transports.
2. **R. O. No. 123-11-12 (9-42)** submitting a communication from Donald Gore, M.D. requesting that the City paint white crosswalk lines at the north side of the junction of Clement and 3<sup>rd</sup> St. due to safety issues for people living in the area.
