Approval of the minutes of the Public Protection and Safety Committee meeting from August 14, 2013.

1. **Com. No. 14-13-14 (3.1)** from Vivian Gerk stating that neighbors from N. 2<sup>nd</sup> St. down to Barrett and North Point Dr. are lighting campfires 4 – 5 nights per week and campfire smoke is entering other neighbors' windows and causing a health hazard.
2. **Com. No. 15-13-14 (3.2)** from James Krosher stating that he is upset over the fact that the City is enforcing a no biking ordinance along the river from the Point Harbor condominiums possibly to the 8<sup>th</sup> St. Bridge.
3. **R. O. No. 109-13-14 (4.1)** from Karen Schmeiser stating that there is a major safety issue at the intersection of N. 14<sup>th</sup> St. and Michigan Ave. and requesting that stop lights be installed.
4. **R. O. No. 111-13-14 (4.6)** by the Fire Chief submitting his quarterly report for the period commencing April 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2013.
5. **Gen. Ord. No. 20-13-14 (7.6)** by Alderperson Carlson relating to 15 minute parking limits so as to add the parking limits on the north and south side of Orchard Drive between S. 11<sup>th</sup> Place and S. 12<sup>th</sup> Street.
