Call to order – The eleventh meeting of the 2010-11 Public Protection & Safety Committee
The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Co-Chairperson M.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Introduction of Committee Members

- 1. Com. No. 37-10-11 (11-21)** from Joell Lamb requesting that winter parking signs, no parking this side of street from December 1 to April 1, be posted on the north side of Bell Ave. from N. 3rd to N. 13th St. Steve Gilbertson stated that he sent out a survey late last week to the residents with a time frame to respond until next week. He asked that this be held until the survey results come in. A motion to hold until the results from a survey come was made by Alderperson Heidemann, seconded by Alderperson Sampson. All ayes, motion carried.
- 2. Com. No. 41-10-11 (12-22)** from Vicki Filipiak, owner of Out East Hair Designers, regarding issues she has been having in front of her business at 2331 N. 6th St. with crumbling pavement and broken curbs which are causing dangerous situations for customers. It was stated that Public Works settled this communication at their meeting on 9/29/10. A motion to file was made by Alderperson Heidemann, seconded by Alderperson Sampson. All ayes, motion carried.
- 3. Gen. Ord. No. 26-10-11 (12-41)** by Alderperson Kittelson an ordinance relating to No Parking Here to Corner so as to change the parking limits on the west side of N. 17th Street. Motion to send to council with favorable recommendations by #1, seconded #2. All ayes motion carried.
- 4. Gen. Ord. No. 28-10-11 (12-43)** by Alderperson Versey an ordinance creating Section 18-47 of the Municipal Code so as to place restrictions on dangerous and vicious dogs in general as well as certain breeds deemed to be dangerous. Assistant City Attorney Chuck Adams discussed the ordinance. A motion to send to council with a favorable recommendation was made by Alderperson Heidemann, seconded by Alderperson Sampson. All ayes, motion carried.
- 5. R.O. No. 153-10-11 (8-29)** by City Clerk submitting information from Alderperson Versey regarding the "Requirement of the City of Milwaukee Pit bull and Rottweiler Ordinance. A motion was made to file the R.O. by Alderperson Heidemann, seconded by Alderperson Sampson. All ayes, motion carried.

6. **Gen. Ord. No. 29-10-11 (12-44)** by Alderpersons Kittelson and Montemayor an ordinance repealing and recreating Section 74-63 of the Sheboygan Municipal Code, entitled "Fire Control" so as to allow, with restrictions, fires within designated fire rings in city parks and city-owned property in the City. Information was relayed to the committee by Fire Chief Hermann. A motion was made to refer to the parks committee and public works with a favorable recommendation by Alderperson Heidemann, seconded by Alderperson Montemayor. All ayes, motion carried.
7. **R.O. No. 206-10-11 (11-60)** by City Clerk submitting a communication from RoseMarie Wilke-Hassmann requesting impacted parking in front of her home at 824 St. Clair Ave. Ryan Sazama presented a proposal to eliminate the 2-hour parking between 8th and 9th Street on St. Clair Avenue. A motion to recommend that an ordinance be drafted to eliminate 2-hour parking and file the RO was made by Alderperson Heidemann, seconded by Alderperson Sampson. All ayes, motion carried
