MEMBERS PRESENT: Alderpersons Kittelson, Montemayor, Sampson, Dekker and Heidemann

Call to order – The thirteenth meeting of the 2010-11 Public Protection & Safety Committee
The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chairperson Kittelson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Introduction of Committee Members and Guests

Approval of the minutes of the Public Protection and Safety Committee meeting from October 13, 2010. Alderperson Heidemann moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson Dekker. All aye – motion passed.

1. **Com. No. 44-10-11 (14-20)** from Amy Groth regarding the odors coming from the mink farm. Amy Groth was present and spoke about her concerns. She noted that the odor is worse this year than it has been in the past. Alderperson Kittelson suggested that Ms. Groth may approach the town or may talk to an attorney regarding her recourse with a private nuisance action. Ryan Sazama advised that he could assist Ms. Groth with contact information for the appropriate municipality. Alderperson Montemayor moved to file. Seconded by Alderperson Dekker. All aye – motion passed.
2. **R. O. No. 254-10-11 (14-22)** submitting the report of the Building Inspection Department for the month of September 2010. Alderperson Montemayor moved to accept and file. Seconded by Alderperson Dekker. All aye – motion passed.
3. **R. O. No. 255-10-11 (14-23)** by the Chief of Police submitting the quarterly report of departmental activity for the period commencing July 1, 2010 and ending September 30, 2010. Alderperson Montemayor moved to accept and file. Seconded by Alderperson Sampson. All aye – motion passed.
4. **Gen. Ord. No. 36-10-11 (14-42)** by Alderperson Kittelson relating to 3 hour parking limits so as to remove the 3 hour parking limit located on the south side of St. Clair Ave. east of the curb line of N. 9th St. Alderperson Montemayor moved to approve and send to Council with a favorable recommendation. Seconded by Alderperson Dekker. All aye – motion passed.
5. **Gen. Ord. No. 37-10-11 (14-43)** by Alderperson Kittelson relating to 2 hour parking limits so as to remove the two hour parking limit on the north side of St. Clair Ave. east of the curb line of N. 9th St. Alderperson Montemayor moved to approve and send to Council

with a favorable recommendation. Seconded by Alderperson Dekker. All aye – motion passed.

6. **R. O. No. 256-10-11 (14-27)** submitting an application for a waiver of the Sex Offender residency restrictions from David A. Fischer. David Fischer was present. Mr. Fischer is living at 2624 S. 8th Street and requesting to move to 2519 S. 8th Street. After review, Alderperson Montemayor moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson Kittelson. Motion passed 3 (Kittelson, Montemayor, Sampson) to 2 (Dekker, Heidemann.)
7. **R. O. No. 257-10-11 (14-28)** from Matt Kraus, of the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections, filing an appeal to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions on behalf of parolee Christopher Jolitz. Matt Kraus was present. He advised that Christopher Jolitz will be paroled on November 9th and the request is for Mr. Jolitz to live at a TLP. After review, Alderperson Montemayor moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson Kittelson. All aye – motion passed.
8. **R. O. No. 258-10-11 (14-45)** from Matt Kraus, of the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections, filing an appeal to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions on behalf of parolee Jesus Ruiz. Matt Kraus explained that the request is for Jesus Ruiz to live at a TLP. After review, Alderperson Heidemann moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson Montemayor. All aye – motion passed.
9. Discussion and possible action – budget reviews:

Fire Department: Alderperson Montemayor moved to approve the Fire Department budget as submitted by Chief Hermann. Seconded by Alderperson Kittelson. Motion passed 4 (Dekker, Kittelson, Montemayor, Sampson) to 1 (Heidemann.)

Police Department: Alderperson Montemayor moved to approve the Police Department budget as submitted by Chief Domagalski. Seconded by Alderperson Dekker. Motion passed 4 (Dekker, Kittelson, Montemayor, Sampson) to 1 (Heidemann.)

Building Inspection Department: Alderperson Dekker moved to approve the Building Inspection Department budget. All aye – motion passed.

Emergency Operations Center: Alderperson Dekker moved to approve the Emergency Operations Center budget. All aye – motion passed.
