Call to order – The fifteenth meeting of the 2010-11 Public Protection & Safety Committee
The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Chairperson Kittelson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Introduction of Committee Members and Guests

Approval of the minutes of the Public Protection and Safety Committee meeting from November 10, 2010. Alderperson Montemayor moved to approve, seconded by Alderperson Sampson. All ayes – motion passed.

- 1. Comm. No. 45-10-11 (16-20)** from Peter Scheibel of The Vollrath Co. regarding issues with trucks being pulled over on N. 23rd St. between Kohler Memorial Dr. and Superior Ave. and stating that there are no signs posted to not allow truck traffic on this section of road. A discussion took place with regard to posting this area as a truck route to make it easier for trucks delivering to The Vollrath Company and to prevent the drivers from receiving tickets for violation of driving on a no truck route. A motion was made to direct that an ordinance be drafted to post as a truck route and be brought back to this committee by Alderperson Heidemann, seconded by Alderperson Montemayor. All ayes, motion passed.
- 2. Comm. No. 46-10-11 (16-21)** from Tom Turks requesting that a light on the electrical pole be placed in the alley between Kentucky and Alabama Ave. and between S. 7th and 8th Sts. due to gang symbols being painted on the garages. A discussion was held in regard to the lighting in the alley. Chad Pelishek stated that at this point, that particular neighborhood will be addressed in the next 2 years. Mr. Pelishek stated that he would gather information from Alliant and relay that to Mr. Turks. A motion was made to file the request by Alderperson Sampson, seconded by Alderperson Montemayor. All ayes, motion passed.
- 3. R. O. No. 303-10-11 (16-33)** submitting a communication from Laurie Zen Netzow POA regarding a question and concern of what the connection fees are to hook up to a mini-storm sewer. Laurie Zen Netzow presented her concerns with regard to the cost of the mini sewer hookup. The City Engineer pointed out that the property in question is considered a commercial property and the ordinance clearly states that the fee for hookup is \$1,000.00 A motion was made to file the document and send a letter of apology to Ms.

Zen Netzow, was made by Alderperson Heidemann, seconded by Alderperson Montemayor. All ayes, motion passed.

4. **R. O. No. 154-10-11 (16-54)** by Alderperson Kittelson a resolution authorizing application for 2011 Wisconsin Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety, Data Driven Approaches To Crime and Traffic Safety Grant Solicitation. A motion was made to accept and send to counsel with a favorable recommendation was made by Alderperson Montemayor, seconded by Alderperson Heidemann. All ayes, motion passed.
5. **R.O. No. 153-10-11 (16-53)** by Alderperson Kittelson a resolution amending the city's bond schedule.
6. **Gen. Ord. No. 42-10-11 (16-63)** by Alderperson Kittelson an ordinance repealing and recreating various portions of Chapter 26 of the Sheboygan Municipal Code so as to change the forfeiture structure for violations of the chapter, effective June 1, 2011.
7. **Gen. Ord. No. 43-10-11 (16-64)** by Alderperson Kittelson an ordinance repealing and recreating subsection (a) of sec. 1-13 of the Sheboygan Municipal Code and sec. 1-14 of the Sheboygan Municipal Code so as to update the statutory authority for the issuance of citations and to provide additional authority for specific city officials to issue citations directly related to the official responsibilities of said officials.

R.O. 16-53 and Gen. Ord. No. 16-63 and 16-64 were combined as one.

A motion to approve and send to counsel with a favorable recommendation was made by Alderperson Montemayor, seconded by Alderperson Heidemann. All ayes, motion passed.

8. **R. O. No. 278-10-11 (15-25)** submitting a request for a waiver of the Sex Offender Residency restrictions from Eric Reineking. A motion to approve the waiver for Eric Reineking to move to 1423 Mehrrens Avenue, made by Alderperson Montemayor, seconded by Alderperson Sampson. Two (2) ayes, one (1) opposed, chair votes yes, motion passed.
9. **R. O. No. 304-10-11 (16-34)** submitting a communication from the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections filing a request for a waiver to the Sex Offender residency restrictions on behalf of Albert Webster. A motion was made to move with his sister at 1623 Erie Avenue made by Alderperson Montemayor, seconded by Alderperson Sampson. All ayes, motion passed.
10. **R. O. No. 305-10-11 (16-35)** submitting a communication from the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections filing a request for a waiver to the Sex Offender residency restrictions on behalf of State inmate Brandon Horzen. A motion was made to place Mr. Horzen in TLP made by Alderperson Sampson, seconded by Alderperson Montemayor. All ayes, motion passed.
11. **R.O. No. 306-10-11 (16-36)** submitting a communication from the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections filing a request for a waiver to the Sex Offender residency restrictions on behalf of State inmate Bee Her. A motion was made to place Mr. Her in the TLP made by Alderperson Montemayor, seconded by Alderperson Heidemann. All ayes, motion passed.
