Chairperson Rindfleisch called the meeting to order at 5:02 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Introduction of committee members, staff and guests.

A motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting held December 14, 2010 was made by Ald. VanderWeele and seconded by Ald. Wangemann. **All ayes; motion approved.**

**R.O. No. 302-10-11 (16-65) – Various License Applications: Bev. Op. Lic. App. Nos. 8903 (Leah S. Knepfel) and 8892 (Elizabeth W. Luedke)**

Submitting various license applications for the period ending June 30, 2011 and June 30, 2012.

Leah S. Knepfel failed to appear before the committee, but had telephoned the City Attorney's office to indicate that she was unable to appear at the meeting because of her work schedule. Ms. Knepfel was told to appear before the committee at its January 11th meeting and will be sent a letter via regular mail.
