

**Minutes: City of Sheboygan Board Police & Fire Commissioners
(3/8/2012)**

The Board of Police and Fire Commissioners of the City of Sheboygan met on Thursday March 8, 2012. This meeting was held at the Sheboygan Police Department Headquarters at 1315 N. 23rd Street in Sheboygan, WI.

President Bill Gottsacker called the meeting to order at 4:00 pm. Commission members in attendance: President: Bill Gottsacker, Secretary: Andrew Hopp, Commissioner Jim Pragatz, Commissioner John Webster and Commissioner Henry Jung.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Approval of the 1/28/2012 Meeting Minutes: Commissioner Jung moved and Commissioner John Webster seconded to approve the minutes. The motion passed with all in favor with Commissioner Hopp abstaining.

Police Chief Domagalski presented copies of the Sheboygan Police Department Annual Report to all Commission members. A discussion followed in which the Chief explained the excellent progress being made through implementation of the department using more of a data driven model.
