UPDATE ON JOINT DISPATCH

The County Law Committee met on March 20, 2012 and passed Resolution No. 28 (2011/12) resolving that the Sheboygan County Board agrees to the concept of an emergency dispatch center administered by Sheboygan County to serve the entire County, including the City of Sheboygan, and directs that the Sheriff and County Administrator negotiate an agreement with the City of Sheboygan.

The document was then referred to the County Finance Committee for their meeting on March 27, 2012.
