NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON AMENDMENT TO THE SHEBOYGAN ZONING ORDINANCE

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held at 7:00 P.M., June 6, 2011, in the Council Chambers of the City Hall, Sheboygan, Wisconsin, to give persons an opportunity to be heard relative to the proposed amendment to the City of Sheboygan's Official Zoning Ordinance. The purpose of the amendment in the text of the Zoning Ordinance is to permit Junkyard or Salvage Yard as a conditional use within the UI Urban Industrial District as follows:

Section 1. Section 15.105 of the Sheboygan Official Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended in Subsection (3)(h)2.c. thereof relating to the land uses permitted as conditional use so as to add the following:

"Section 15.105(3)(h)2.c.

...

Junkyard or Salvage Yard (per Section 15.206(5)(d))"

Section 2. Section 15.203 of the Sheboygan Official Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended in Subsection (5)(d) thereof relating to the table of land uses for storage/disposal so as to add the following:

"C" under Zoning District Abbreviations in the UI District for Junkyard or Salvage Yard.

Section 3. Section 15.206 of the Sheboygan Official Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended in Subsection (5)(d)3. thereof relating to Junkyard or Salvage Yard so as to read as follows:

"Section 15.206(5)(d) Junkyard or Salvage Yard

...

3. Conditional Use Regulations {RA-35ac, HI, UI}:

- a. Facility shall provide a bufferyard with a minimum opacity of 1.00 along all borders of the property abutting residentially zoned property (see Section 15.610).
- b. All buildings, structures, outdoor storage areas, and any other activity areas shall be located a minimum of 100 feet from all lot lines.
- c. In no instance shall activity areas be located within a required frontage landscaping or bufferyard area.
- d. Shall not involve the storage, handling or collection of hazardous materials, including any of the materials listed in Section 15.719.
- e. Shall comply with Section 15.905, standards and procedures applicable to all conditional uses.
- f. In the UI District, permitted uses include Junkyards or Salvage Yards that operated prior to adoption of the 1996 zoning ordinance (Subs. Gen. Ord. No. 10-96-97) and consist of not less than 13 acres. This does not permit the expansion of land area for existing Junkyard or Salvage Yard uses or creation of new Junkyard or Salvage in the UI District."

Section 4. All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and this ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage and publication.

ORDINANCE ON SECOND READING

Gen. Ord. No. 61 - 10 - 11. By Alderperson VanderWeele. April 18, 2011.

AN ORDINANCE repealing and recreating Subsection 70-6(a)(2) of the Municipal Code so as to clarify the definition of an enclosed place in the statewide smoking ban.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHEBOYGAN DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subsection 70-6(a)(2) of the Municipal Code is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

“Sec. 70-6. *Smoking prohibited.*

(a) Adoption of Statewide smoking ban.

...

(2) In addition to the definition of “enclosed place” set forth in Section 101.123, Wis. Stats., an enclosed place for the purposes of this ordinance shall include the following:

- a. All space between a floor and a ceiling that is bounded by walls, doors, or windows, whether open or closed, covering more than 75 percent of the combined surface area of the vertical planes constituting the perimeter of the area. A wall includes any retractable divider, garage door, or other physical barrier, whether temporary or permanent. A 0.011 gauge screen with an 18 by 16 mesh count is not a wall.
- b. All space within a restaurant, tavern, private club, or retail establishment that must be used by patrons in order to move between the primary serving area, the entrances and exits, and the restrooms.

...”

Section 2. All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and this ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage and publication.
