Call to order – The twentieth meeting of the 2013-14 Public Protection & Safety Committee
The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chairperson Carlson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Approval of the minutes of the Public Protection and Safety Committee meeting from
March 26, 2014. Alderperson Versey moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson Lessard.
Motion passed – all ayes.

- 1. R. O. No. 279-13-14 (8.3)** from Alderperson Belanger on behalf of his constituent Michael Thomas regarding issues he is having with parking near his home near North High School. Ryan Sazama advised that according to study data, the area does meet impact parking criteria. After discussion, Alderperson Versey moved to ask the City Engineer to draft an ordinance to create impact parking on the west side of the street on N. 11th between North and School Ave. Seconded by Alderperson Lessard. Motion passed – all ayes.
- 2. R. O. No. 338-13-14 (3.9)** from Denny Moyer, General Manager of the Sheboygan Athletic Club, requesting a street closing for Wildwood Ave. from New Jersey Ave. north to the projected Virginia Ave., May 30, 2014, as they are hosting Project Grill. Denny Moyer was present. Chairman Carlson advised Mr. Moyer that the committee was informed by the City Attorney that they need to apply for a street festival permit. No action is required by the committee. Alderperson Versey moved to file. Seconded by Alderperson Lessard. Motion passed – all ayes.
- 3. R. O. No. 339-13-14 (3.10)** from the John Michael Kohler Arts Center making various requests of the City for the 44th Annual Midsummer Festival of the Arts on July 19 and 20, 2014. Chairman Carlson advised that the process is the same. They need to apply through the City Clerk's office for a street festival permit. Alderperson Versey moved to file. Seconded by Alderperson Lessard. Motion passed – all ayes.
- 4. R. O. No. 340-13-14 (3.13)** submitting a report relative to the purchase of a new in-car audio/video capture, recording and storage system for the Sheboygan Police Department. This was discussed with Item 5, **Res. No. 168-13-14**. Chief Domagalski explained that the current equipment is beyond its useful life, it is no longer supported, so it needs to be replaced. The Chief spoke about the integrated video system outlined in the bid.

Alderson Lessard moved to accept and file the R. O. and approve the resolution. Seconded by Alderson Versey. Motion passed – all ayes.

5. **Res. No. 168-13-14 (4.4)** by Alderson Carlson authorizing the Purchasing Agent to enter into an agreement for the purchase of 17 in-car audio/video recording systems for the Sheboygan Police Department including installation and training. This was discussed with Item 4, **R. O. No. 340-13-14**. A motion to approve the resolution passed unanimously.
6. **R. O. No. 341-13-14 (8.1)** submitting a communication from James Reinl putting in a request to cut the flip flop parking at the same time as daylight savings time ends, which is before April 1st for year to year – not just one time. Ryan Sazama advised that DPW does not want to change the winter parking rules. Alderson Lessard moved to file. Seconded by Alderson Versey. Motion passed – all ayes.
7. **R. O. No. 334-13-14 (3.5)** submitting a communication from James Canon requesting a waiver from the Sex Offender Residency restrictions in order to live at 1233 Michigan Ave. James Canon was present. After discussion, Alderson Donohue moved for approval of the waiver. Seconded by Alderson Lessard. Motion passed – all ayes.
9. **R. O. No. 336-13-14 (3.7)** submitting a communication from Elmer Schneider requesting a waiver from the Sex Offender Residency restrictions in order to live at 2133 S. 8th Street. Elmer Schneider was present. After discussion, Alderson Donohue moved for approval of the waiver. Seconded by Alderson Lessard. Motion passed – all ayes.
8. **R. O. No. 335-13-14 (3.6)** submitting a communication from Dwayne Davis requesting a waiver from the Sex Offender Residency restrictions in order to live at 2329 S. 16th Street. Dwayne Davis was present. After discussion, Alderson Lessard moved to deny. Seconded by Alderson Versey. Discussion continued. The motion to deny did not pass: Aldersons Lessard and Versey – aye, Aldersons Carlson and Donohue – nay.
10. **R. O. No. 337-13-14 (3.8)** submitting a communication from Daniel Ludwigson requesting a waiver from the Sex Offender Residency restrictions in order to live at 1124C Erie Ave. Daniel Ludwigson was present. After discussion, Alderson Donohue moved for approval of the waiver. Seconded by Alderson Carlson. The motion to approve did not pass: Aldersons Carlson and Donohue aye, Aldersons Lessard and Versey nay.
