Call to order – The first meeting of the 2014-15 Public Protection & Safety Committee
The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chairperson Carlson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

An introduction of all the committee members and Probation officers in attendance was made.

Approval of the minutes of the Public Protection and Safety Committee meeting from April 9, 2014. A motion to approve was made by Alderperson Lessard, seconded by Alderperson Bitters. All ayes, motion carried.

1. The Chief of Police spoke reference the culling of the deer. Sharp shooters took out 20 deer which included 23 fetuses for a total of 43 deer from January until the present time. The next step will be to address the city ordinance.
2. **R. O.
