Call to order – The twelfth meeting of the 2013-14 Public Protection & Safety Committee
The meeting was called to order at 3:15 p.m. by Chairperson Carlson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Approval of the minutes of the Public Protection and Safety Committee meeting from August 28, 2013. Alderperson Donohue moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson Lessard. Motion passed – all ayes.

- 1. Com. No. 17-13-14 (3.1)** submitting a communication from Jane Weber requesting a “No Dogs Allowed” sign at the end of Indiana Avenue. A motion was made to post No Dogs Allowed signs at the end of Indiana Avenue on the beach by Alderperson Donohue, seconded by Alderperson Lessard. All ayes, motion carried.
- 2. Com. No. 18-13-14 (3.2)** submitting a communication from Patricia Hornes stating that she is concerned that Sheboygan no longer has a target range in the basement of Urban Middle School for her or others to have any shooting practice. A motion was made to file with Chairperson Carlson stating he would communicate with Patricia by Alderperson Donohue, seconded by Alderperson Lessard. All ayes, motion carried.
- 3. Gen. Ord. No. 23-13-14 (7.1)** by Alderperson Hammond. An ordinance relating to parking restrictions to remove two (2) handicapped parking stalls behind City Hall immediately east and west of the back door (north side of City Hall). Motion to approve by Alderperson Lessard, seconded by chairperson. All ayes, motion carried.
- 4. Gen. Ord. No. 24-13-14 (7.2)** by Alderpersons Carlson and Heidemann. An ordinance creating section 118-137 of the Municipal Code, entitled “Trailer Parking,” so as to prohibit overnight parking of trailers in the city. A motion was made to approve the ordinance by Alderperson Donohue, seconded by Alderperson Lessard. All ayes, motion carried.
- 5. Gen. Ord. No. 25-13-14 (7.3)** by Alderperson Carlson. An ordinance amending various portions of Chapter 26 of the Municipal Code relating to establishment of new fees for permits issued by the Building Inspection Division of the City of Sheboygan. A motion to approve was made by Alderperson Donohue, seconded by Alderperson Lessard. All ayes, motion carried.

6. **Gen. Ord. No. 26-13-14 (6.1)** by Alderperson Carlson. An ordinance requiring east and westbound traffic on Arizona Ave. and Elm Ave. to stop at S. 21st St. A motion to approve was made by Alderperson Lessard, seconded by Alderperson Donohue. All ayes, motion carried.
7. **Gen. Ord. No. 27-13-14 (6.2)** by Alderperson Carlson. An ordinance repealing Gen. Ord. 40-02-03 creating a no parking, stopping, standing zone on the south side of Cooper Ave. west of N. 20th St. A motion to approve was made by Alderperson Lessard, seconded by Alderperson Donohue. All ayes, motion carried.
8. **Gen. Ord. No. 28-13-14 (6.3)** by Alderperson Carlson. An ordinance creating a no parking zone from 7 a.m. until 4 p.m. on school days on the north side of Cooper Ave. west of N. 20th St. A motion to approve was made by Alderperson Lessard, seconded by Alderperson Donohue. All ayes, motion carried.
9. **Gen. Ord. No. 29-13-14 (6.4)** by Alderperson Carlson. An ordinance creating a no parking zone effective December 1st through April 1st on the south side of Ontario Ave. west of N. 14th St. A motion to approve was made by Alderperson Lessard, seconded by Alderperson Donohue. All ayes, motion carried.
10. **Gen. Ord. No. 30-13-14 (6.5)** by Alderperson Heidemann. An ordinance creating a no parking zone in the alley north of Jefferson Ave. and south of Pennsylvania Ave. between S. 9th St. and Water St. A motion to approve was made by Alderperson Lessard, seconded by Alderperson Donohue. All ayes, motion carried.
11. **Gen. Ord. No. 31-13-14 (6.6)** by Alderperson Carlson. An ordinance creating a no parking zone on the west side of S. 24th St. south of Union Ave. A motion to approve was made by Alderperson Lessard, seconded by Alderperson Donohue. All ayes, motion carried.
12. **Gen. Ord. No. 32-13-14 (6.7)** by Alderperson Carlson. An ordinance creating a no parking zone on the north side of Union Ave. between S. 26th St. and S. 25th St. A motion to approve was made by Alderperson Lessard, seconded by Alderperson Donohue. All ayes, motion carried.
13. **R. C. No. 81-13-14 (6.4)** by Public Protection and Safety. Your Committee to whom was referred R. C. No. 60-13-14 by Finance and Res. No. 13-13-14 by Alderperson Carlson amending the city's bond schedule; recommends sending the document back to Council with no recommendations. A motion was made to hold by Alderperson Donohue, seconded by Alderperson Lessard. All ayes, motion carried.
14. **R. C. No. 82-13-14 (6.5)** by Public Protection and Safety. Your Committee to whom was referred Res. No. 14-13-14 by Alderperson Carlson providing a list of approved evidence-based alcohol education programs pursuant to §70-154(c)(2), Sheboygan Municipal Code; recommends sending the document back to Council with no recommendations. A motion was made to hold by Alderperson Donohue, seconded by Alderperson Lessard. All ayes, motion carried.
15. **R. C. No. 83-13-14 (6.6)** by Public Protection and Safety. Your Committee to whom was referred Gen. Ord. No. 8-13-14 by Alderperson Carlson creating section 70-154 of the

Municipal Code, entitled "Public Intoxication," so as to prohibit intoxication in public places, provide a penalty, and provide an alternative to said penalty in certain situations; recommends sending the document back to Council with no recommendations. A motion was made to hold by Alderperson Donohue, seconded by Alderperson Lessard. All ayes, motion carried.

16. **Res. No. 56-13-14 (5.4)** by Alderperson Carlson. A resolution authorizing the appropriate City Officials to submit an application for the Wisconsin Department of Justice Heroin Initiative 2013 and administer the grant if awarded. A motion to approve was made by Alderperson Lessard, seconded by Alderperson Donohue. All ayes, motion carried.
17. **Res. No. 57-13-14 (5.5)** By Alderperson Carlson. A resolution authorizing the Sheboygan Police Department to submit a grant application to the American Automobile Association for the purchase of an intoxiclock device. A motion was made to approve by Alderperson Donohue, seconded by Alderperson Lessard. All ayes, motion carried.
18. **Res. No. 57-13-14 (5.5)** By Alderperson Carlson. A resolution authorizing the Sheboygan Police Department to submit a grant application to the American Automobile Association for the purchase of an intoxiclock device. A motion was made to approve and file by Alderperson Donohue, seconded by Alderperson Lessard. All ayes, motion carried.

No. 139-13-14 (3.4)** Submitting a communication from Walter Holzhaeuser requesting that the stop lights located at the intersection of N. 13th Street and Geele Ave. be removed and replaced with stop signs. A motion to hold was made by Alderperson Donohue, seconded by Alderperson Lessard. All ayes, motion carried.

Submitting an evaluation of Request for Bids #1734-13-3 received on September 5, 2013 for the purchase of one 4WD Pickup for the Fire Department. Emergency lighting and accessories will be purchased separately and installed by the City following receipt of the vehicle. A motion was made to approve and file by Alderperson Donohue, seconded by Alderperson Lessard. All ayes, motion carried.
