

PUBLIC PROTECTION AND SAFETY COMMITTEE

MINUTES

DATE: Wednesday, October 23, 2013

Call to order – The thirteenth meeting of the 2013-14 Public Protection & Safety Committee
The meeting was called to order at 3:02 p.m. by Chairperson Carlson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Approval of the minutes of the Public Protection and Safety Committee meeting from
October 2, 2013. Alderperson VanAkkeren moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson
Lessard. Motion passed – 3 - 0.

- 1. R. O. No. 139-13-14 (3.4)** from Walter Holzhaeuser requesting that the stop lights located at the intersection of N. 13th Street and Geele Ave. be removed and replaced with stop signs. Ryan Sazama advised that a document went to Council to eliminate the traffic signals and put up a four way stop as the school is closed. Alderperson VanAkkeren moved to file. Seconded by Alderperson Lessard. Motion passed – 4 – 0.
- 2. R. O. No. 156-13-14 (4.6)** from Bill Klein, Principal of Jefferson Elementary School, asking that the “No Parking” signs on 15th and 16th Streets be removed for safety of the students, parents and staff members. Alderperson Lessard moved to hold. Seconded by Alderperson VanAkkeren. Motion passed – all ayes.
- 3. R. O. No. 158-13-14 (7.5)** from Alderperson Lewandoske submitting a proposal that no changes be made to any parking area within 1,000 (one thousand) feet of Sheboygan’s City Hall without first being referred to the Public Works Committee and voted on by the full Common Council. Alderperson Lewandoske was present. Alderperson Lessard moved to file. Seconded by Alderperson VanAkkeren. Discussion took place regarding why one area in the City of Sheboygan would be singled out, why the Public Works Committee was chosen for referral, and whether a parking area included streets or parking lots. After discussion, the motion to file passed – all ayes.
- 4. R. O. No. 110-13-14 (4.2)** submitting a communication from Jeremy Hamilton requesting a waiver to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions in order to live at 1309 Pennsylvania Ave. Jeremy Hamilton did not appear. Alderperson VanAkkeren moved to file. After discussion, Alderperson VanAkkeren amended his motion to deny. Seconded by Alderperson Lessard. The motion to deny passed – all ayes.
- 5. R. O. No. 141-13-14 (3.6)** submitting a communication from Wydell Vaughn requesting a waiver to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions in order to live at 910 Indiana Ave.,

Apartment 12. Wydell Vaughn did not appear. After discussion, Alderperson VanAkkeren moved to deny. Seconded by Alderperson Lessard. Alderperson Carlson requested that Sgt. Riddiough contact Mr. Vaughn to let him know he needs to wait 90 days to reapply. Motion to deny passed – all ayes.

6. **R. O. No. 155-13-14 (4.5)** submitting a communication from Edwin L. Fritz requesting a waiver to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions in order to live at 2610D Cross Creek Dr. Sgt. Riddiough of the Police Department advised that per Lt. Brassier and the Assistant City Attorney, Mr. Fritz did not need to appear because he is requesting to live with an immediate family member who has resided at the address for more than two years. Alderperson VanAkkeren moved to file. Seconded by Alderperson Lessard. Motion passed – all ayes.
7. **R. O. No. 157-13-14 (4.7)** submitting a communication from James Gierke (Cahala) requesting a waiver to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions in order to live at 1416 S. 9th St. James Gierke Cahala was present. After discussion, Alderperson Donohue moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson Lessard. Motion passed – all ayes.

MATTERS TO HOLD

These three documents will remain on hold.

R. C. No. 81-13-14 (6.4) Your Committee to whom was referred R. C. No. 60-13-14 by Finance and Res. No. 13-13-14 by Alderperson Carlson amending the City's bond schedule; recommends sending the document back to Council with no recommendations.

R. C. No. 82-13-14 (6.5) Your Committee to whom was referred Res. No. 14-13-14 by Alderperson Carlson providing a list of approved evidence-based alcohol education programs pursuant to §70-154(c)(2), Sheboygan Municipal Code; recommends sending the document back to Council with no recommendations.

R. C. No. 83-13-14 (6.6) Your Committee to whom was referred Gen. Ord. No. 8-13-14 by Alderperson Carlson creating section 70-154 of the Municipal Code, entitled "Public Intoxication" so as to prohibit intoxication in public places, provide a penalty, and provide an alternative to said penalty in certain situations; recommends sending the document back to Council with no recommendations.
