Approval of the minutes of the Public Protection and Safety Committee meeting from April 24, 2013.

1. **R. O. No. 13-13-14 (6.2)** By Public Works. Your Committee to whom was referred R. O. No. 341-12-13 by the City Clerk submitting a communication from Alderperson Matichek stating that he had a citizen request a street light to be installed on a wooden pole off the alley at 513 S. 14th St. for safety reasons; recommends that the document be referred to Public Protection and Safety.
