Call to order – The twenty-first meeting of the 2011-12 Public Protection & Safety Committee
The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chairperson Kittelson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Approval of the minutes of the Public Protection and Safety Committee meeting from
March 14, 2012. Alderperson Dekker moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson Sampson.
All aye - motion passed.

1. **Com. No. 16-11-12 (4.1)** Submitting a communication from Menhard Sonnemann requesting that Sheboygan adopt the Towing Ordinance that tows uninsured motorists that has been approved by the Dallas Police Department. A motion to file was made by Alderperson Dekker, seconded by Alderperson Carlson. All aye – motion carried.
2. **Gen. Ord. No. 77-11-12 (8.4)** by Alderperson Bohren an ordinance relating to changing the speed limit on Eisner Avenue between Lakeshore Road and N. 21st Street to 25 miles per hour. A motion to approve reduce the speed limit was made by Alderperson Dekker, seconded by Alderperson Carlson. All aye – motion carried.
3. **Gen. Ord. No. 78-11-12 (8.5)** by Alderperson Kittelson an ordinance relating to mid-block crosswalks so as to add a mid-block crosswalk on Gateway Drive north of Behrens Parkway. A motion to approve was made by Alderperson Sampson, seconded by Alderperson Carlson. All aye – motion carried.
4. **Gen. Ord. No. 79-11-12 (8.6)** by Alderperson Kittelson an ordinance relating to handicapped parking so as to create an on-street handicapped parking zone on the north side of Grand Avenue east of North 11th Street. A motion to approve was made by Alderperson Dekker, seconded by Alderperson Carlson. All aye – motion carried.
5. **Gen. Ord. No. 81-11-12 (8.8)** by Alderpersons Versey and Carlson an ordinance repealing and re-creating Article VI Division 3 of Chapter 50 of the Municipal Code, entitled “Smoke Detectors” so as to update the smoke detector ordinance, including definitions, require specific types of smoke alarms, and. A motion to approve for discussion was made by Alderperson Carlson, seconded by Alderperson Dekker as well as a motion to withdraw by Alderperson Carlson, seconded by Alderperson Dekker.

A motion was made to hold for further discussion by Alderperson Carlson, seconded by Alderperson Dekker. All aye – motion carried.

6. **R.O. No. 395-11-12 (5.0)** by Fire Chief submitting the Third and Fourth Quarter 2011 EMS Quality Assurance and Quality Improvement Report (July 1, 2011 – December 31, 2011). A motion was made to accept and file by Alderperson Dekker, seconded by Alderperson Sampson. All aye – motion carried.

MOTION TO CONVENE INTO CLOSED SESSION under the exemption provided in §19.85(1)(f) of the Wisconsin Statutes for the purpose of consideration of medical, social, or personal histories of specific persons which, if discussed in public, would like have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or data.

7. **R. O. No. 382-11-12 (3.6) / R.O. No. 392-11-12 (5.6) & R. O. No. 403-11-12 (9.14)** submitting a communication from Richard Rupnik requesting a waiver of the Sex Offender Residency restrictions in order to live at 1021 N. 8th St. #11, 710 Erie Ave. #3.

Note: The first R.O. 382-11-12 (3.6) was held from the last meeting. The Clerk's Office also received two R.O. No. 392-11-12 (5.6) and R.O. No. 403-11-12 (9.14) which are identical to each other. She stated that these could be done as one.

Motion to live at 710 Erie Avenue died for lack of a second.

A motion to deny living at 710 Erie Avenue Apt. 3 was made by Alderperson Dekker, seconded by Alderperson Sampson. 3 nays, 1 aye, motion carried.

8. **R.O. No. 389-11-12 (5.3)** submitting a communication from Zachary Castillo requesting a waiver from the Sex Offender Residency restriction in order to live at 1519 Cambridge Ave. A motion was made to approve by Alderperson Carlson, seconded by Alderperson Sampson, all aye – motion carried.
9. **R.O. No. 390-11-12 (5.4)** submitting a communication from Rodney Fischer requesting a waiver from the Sex Offender Residency restrictions in order to live at 1403 Center Ave. A motion was made to approve by Alderperson Dekker, seconded by Alderperson Sampson, all aye – motion carried.
10. **R.O. No. 391-11-12 (5.5)** submitting a communication from Darnell Johnston requesting a waiver from the Sex Offender Residency restrictions in order to live at 1112 N. 11th St. A motion was made to approve by Alderperson Sampson, seconded by Alderperson Carlson. 3 ayes, 1 nay, motion carried.
11. **R.O. No. 393-11-12 (5.7)** submitting a communication from Mumin Abd-Allah requesting a waiver from the Sex Offender Residence restrictions in order to live at 1028 High Ave. A motion was made to approve by Alderperson Carlson, seconded by Alderperson Sampson, all aye – motion carried.
12. **R.O. No. 394-11-12 (5.8)** submitting a communication from Albert Webster requesting a waiver from the Sex Offender Residence restrictions in order to live at 1214 N. 17th St. A

motion to hold was made by Alderperson Carlson, seconded by Alderperson Sampson, all aye – motion carried.

13. **R.O. No. 404-11-12 (9.15)** submitting a communication from the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections to file an appeal to the Sex Offender Residency restriction on behalf of Jason Rogge in order to place him at a Transitional Living Placement (TLP) at 1123/1125 N. 14th St. or 930A Michigan Ave. based on availability. A motion to approve being placed at the TLP House was made by Alderperson Kittelson, seconded by Alderperson Carlson, all aye – motion carried.
