

# PUBLIC PROTECTION AND SAFETY COMMITTEE

## MINUTES

Call to order – The twenty second meeting of the 2011-12 Public Protection & Safety Committee  
The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chairperson Kittelson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Introduction of Committee Members and Guests

Approval of the minutes of the Public Protection and Safety Committee meeting from March 28, 2012. Alderperson Dekker moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson Carlson. All aye - motion passed.

1. **R. O. No. 414-11-12 (4-7)** submitting a communication from Amy Wilson, Tourism Director for the Sheboygan County Chamber of Commerce, requesting use of the Band Shell at Fountain Park and DPW services to set up chairs and dance floor as needed to fulfill Tourism's obligation with the City in organizing and implementing the Twilight Concert Series, and making various other requests for 4<sup>th</sup> of July events. Amy Wilson was present. She reported that they will be switching fireworks companies this year to Spectrum Pyrotechnics. They will pre-stage the fireworks the night before. All other requests are the same as in prior years. Alderperson Carlson moved to file with the understanding that City department heads are going to take care of this. Seconded by Alderperson Sampson. All aye – motion passed.
2. **R. O. 415-11-12 (4-8)** submitting the Fire Chief's annual report for 2011. Chief Hermann spoke about the fire inspection analysis table included with the report, noting that the reduced number of fires is a direct result of the fire inspection program. After review and discussion, Alderperson Dekker moved to accept and file. Seconded by Alderperson Sampson. All aye – motion passed.
3. **R. O. No. 394-11-12 (5-8)** submitting a communication from Albert Webster requesting a waiver to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions to live at 1214 N. 17<sup>th</sup> Street. Alderperson Sampson moved to file. Seconded by Alderperson Carlson. All aye – motion passed.
4. **R. O. No. 412-11-12 (4-4)** submitting a communication from Albert Webster requesting a waiver to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions to live at 1405 N. 17<sup>th</sup> Street. Alderperson Kittelson advised that she spoke to Albert Webster and Matt Kraus of the Department of Corrections was present on Mr. Webster's behalf. After discussion,

Alderson Sampson moved to approve the waiver. Seconded by Alderson Carlson. All aye – motion passed.

5. **R. O. No. 411-11-12 (4-3)** submitting a communication from the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections requesting a waiver of the Sex Offender Residency restrictions on behalf of parolee Tylor Thompson to be placed in Transitional Living Placement (TLP). Matt Kraus of the Department of Corrections was present. After discussion, Alderson Sampson moved to approve placement in TLP. Seconded by Alderson VanAkkeren. All aye – motion passed.
6. **R. O. No. 413-11-12 (4-5)** submitting a communication from George Harris requesting a waiver to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions in order to live at 1507 Michigan Ave. Lieutenant Brassler advised that he spoke to Mr. Harris's probation agent and learned that Mr. Harris is currently in jail and his probation will be revoked. Alderson VanAkkeren moved to file. Seconded by Alderson Carlson. All aye – motion passed.
7. **R. O. No. 416-11-12 (9-4)** submitting a communication from Micheal Brown requesting a waiver to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions to live at 715A Alabama Ave. Micheal Brown was present. After discussion, Alderson VanAkkeren moved to approve. Seconded by Alderson Carlson. All aye – motion passed.
