A motion was made by Alderperson Carlson to direct DPW to contact the DNR to obtain ideas on how to deal with this problem and then refer their findings to the Committee of the Whole, seconded by Alderperson Lessard. All aye, motion carried.

- 2. R. O. 431-11-12 (9.14)** submitting a communication from the Sheboygan Yacht Club requesting that the City of Sheboygan act as the organizing authority under the current ordinances and approve the staging of a fireworks display for Sheboygan Harbor Fest, as

well as providing routine City of Sheboygan services to host such an event with Sheboygan Harbor Fest 2012, Inc.

A motion to approve with a condition that the city is listed as an additional covered party was made by Alderperson Lessard, seconded by Alderperson Heidemann. This motion was withdrawn and changed to read:

A motion was made to re-write a change in the city ordinance by Alderperson Lessard. This was seconded by Alderperson Heidemann. All aye, motion carried.

3. A request from Alderperson Heidemann for discussion and possible action regarding speeding on Lakeshore Drive. Alderperson Heidemann discussed the problems with speeding on Lakeshore Drive. Captain Cobb of the Sheboygan Police Department informed everyone that there is a schedule set up for using the Speed Trailer in different parts of the city and that Lakeshore Drive is on that schedule.
4. **R. O. No. 423-11-12 (4.1)** submitting a communication from Rhyan Zimmerman requesting a waiver to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions so that he can live at 1322 N. 12th St. A motion to deny was made by Alderperson Carlson, seconded by Alderperson Lessard. All aye, motion carried
5. **R. O. No. 428-11-12 (9.8)** submitting a communication from the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections requesting a waiver to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions on behalf of parolee Dakota Knabe for placement at a Transitional Living Placement (TLP). A motion was made by Alderperson Carlson to approve, seconded by Alderperson Heidemann. 4 ayes, 1 abstained, motion carried.
6. **R. O. No. 429-11-12 (93.10)** submitting a communication from Jeremy Hamilton requesting a waiver of the Sex Offender Residency restrictions in order to live at 1703 Illinois Ave. A motion was made to deny by Alderperson Carlson, seconded by Alderperson Heidemann. All aye, motion carried.
