

# PUBLIC PROTECTION AND SAFETY COMMITTEE

## MINUTES

**DATE:** Wednesday, May 30, 2012

**TIME:** 5:00 p.m.

Call to order – The third meeting of the 2012-13 Public Protection & Safety Committee was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chairperson VanAkkeren.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Approval of the minutes of the Public Protection and Safety Committee meeting from May 16, 2012. Alderperson Carlson moved to approve, seconded by Alderperson Lessard. All aye - motion passed.

1. **Gen. Ord. No. 6-12-13 (8.6)** by Alderperson Van Akkeren, an ordinance eliminating the traffic signals at the intersection of N. 9<sup>th</sup> Street and Superior Avenue and creating an ordinance to install a four-way stop at the intersection of N. 9<sup>th</sup> Street and Superior Avenue. A motion was made to file the general ordinance and adopt the substitute ordinances by Alderperson Carlson, seconded by Alderperson Wangemann, all aye, motion carried.
2. **Gen. Ord. No. 7-12-13 (8.7)** by Alderperson VanAkkeren, an ordinance eliminating the traffic signals at the intersection of N. 8<sup>th</sup> Street and Superior Avenue and creating an ordinance to install a four-way stop at the intersection of N. 8<sup>th</sup> Street and Superior Avenue. A motion was made to file the general ordinance and adopt the substitute ordinances by Alderperson Carlson, seconded by Alderperson Wangemann, all aye, motion carried.
3. **Gen. Ord. No. 8-12-13 (7.1)** by Alderperson VanAkkeren, an ordinance repealing and recreating Subsection 26-45(a) of the City of Sheboygan Municipal Code relating to the provision of a local operator for certain properties. A motion was made to approve by Alderperson Heidemann, seconded by Alderperson Wangemann, 4 ayes, 1 abstained, motion carried.
4. **Gen. Ord. No. 9-12-13 (7.2)** by Alderperson VanAkkeren, an ordinance repealing and recreating Sheboygan Municipal Code Section 26-46 relating to the registration of vacant buildings. A motion was made to approve by Alderperson Heidemann, seconded by Alderperson Wangemann, 4 ayes, 1 abstained, motion carried.
5. **Gen. Ord. No. 10-12-13 (7.3)** by Alderpersons Van Akkeren, Carlson, Heidemann, Lessard and Wangemann, an ordinance repealing and recreating Subsection. 50-698(a) of the Sheboygan Municipal Code so as to permit fireworks displays via a permit process.

A motion was made to approve by Alderperson Carlson, seconded by Alderperson Lessard, all aye, motion carried.

6. **Res. No. 14-12-13 (5.4)** by Alderperson Van Akkeren, a resolution authorizing application for the 2012 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program Award, Local Solicitation and entering into a Memorandum of Understanding with Sheboygan County. A motion was made to approve by Alderperson Lessard, seconded by Alderperson Carlson, all aye, motion carried.
7. **R. O. No. 35-12-13 (4.10)** by Fire Chief, pursuant to Section 50-494 of the Municipal Code, I herewith submit my report of departmental activity for the period commencing January 1, 2012, and ending March 31, 2012. A motion was made to accept and file by Alderperson Carlson, seconded by Alderperson Lessard, all aye, motion carried.
8. **R. O. No. 28-12-13 (4.3)** by Chief of Police, pursuant to section 54-65 of the Municipal Code, I herewith submit my quarterly report showing the activities of my department for the period commencing January 1, 2012 and ending March 31, 2012. A motion was made to accept and file by Alderperson Wangemann, seconded by Alderperson Carlson, all aye, motion carried.

12. **R. O. No. 34-12-13 (4.9)** submitting a communication from Lorenzo Saraba requesting to the Sex Offender Residence restrictions in order to live at 1311 N. 29<sup>th</sup> Street. A motion was made to approve by Alderperson Carlson, seconded by Alderperson Heidemann, all aye, motion carried.
13. **R. O. No. 37-12-13 (8.2)** submitting a communication from Steve Hamilton requesting a waiver of the Sex Offender Residence restrictions in order to live at 1703 Erie Ave. A motion was made to approve by Alderperson Carlson, seconded by Chairman VanAkkeren, 2 ayes, 3 nays, motion denied.
