Call to order – The ninth meeting of the 2012-13 Public Protection & Safety Committee
The meeting was called to order at 5:01 p.m. by Chairperson VanAkkeren.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Approval of the minutes of the Public Protection and Safety Committee meeting from August 15, 2012. Alderperson Carlson moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson Lessard. All aye - motion passed.

1. **R. O. No. 109-12-13 (4.7)** from Joseph and Darlene Falle regarding an issue with goats and chickens located at 1419 N. 30th St. Alderperson Carlson moved to file. Police Chief Domagalski provided an update, advising that Officer Rupnick and Dean Hesselink from Building Inspection re-inspected the property and found no violations. Alderperson Lessard seconded the motion to file. All aye – motion passed.
2. **R. O. No. 120-12-13 (4.4)** from Thomas Laiken, Millennium Properties, Inc., requesting that a “no parking” sign on Martin Ave. alongside of his business (Zodiak Bar) be removed to allow customer parking. Mr. Laiken was present. Ryan Sazama advised that he can draft an ordinance to remove the sign. Alderperson Carlson moved that an ordinance be drafted. Seconded by Alderperson Heidemann. Discussion took place regarding parking for deliveries. All aye – motion passed.
3. **R. O. No. 119-12-13 (4.3)** submitting a communication from Adam Strauss requesting a waiver to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions to live at 2638 N. 19th St. Adam Strauss was present. After discussion, Alderperson VanAkkeren moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson Carlson. Motion failed 2 (Carlson, VanAkkeren) aye to 2 (Heidemann, Lessard) nay. Alderperson Carlson moved to hold. Seconded by Alderperson Heidemann. Motion to hold passed – all aye.
4. **R. O. No. 121-12-13 (4.7)** submitting a communication from the State of Wisconsin Department of Corrections requesting a waiver of the Sex Offender Residency restrictions on behalf of Andrew D. Tershner to live at 1123/1125 N. 14th St. or 930A Michigan Ave. depending on availability. Nicole Johnson, Probation & Parole, was present. After discussion, Alderperson Carlson moved to approve. Seconded by Alderperson VanAkkeren. Motion passed 3 (Carlson, Heidemann, VanAkkeren) aye to 1 (Lessard) nay.

5. **R. O. No. 108-12-13 (4.6)** submitting a communication from Rhyan Noel Zimmerman requesting a waiver to the Sex Offender Residency restrictions to live at 1409 S. 17th St. Rhyan Zimmerman did not appear. After discussion, Alderperson Carlson moved to deny. Seconded by Alderperson Heidemann. All aye – motion passed.
