Call to order – The fourteenth meeting of the 2012-13 Public Protection & Safety Committee

- 1. R. O. No. 204-12-13 (4.2)** by Board of Water Commissions. To the Honorable, the Mayor and Common Council:

The Sheboygan Board of Water Commissioners request minor changes to Ordinance Sec. 122-16 in accord with NR 810.15, requiring the municipal water supplier to develop and implement a cross connections control program.
