

FINDING COMMUNITY SERVICE

Since the Court is unable to place the defendant in a community service placement, it is the responsibility of the defendant and his or her parent/parents or guardian to find a suitable agency or organization. The community service must meet the following three criteria to be acceptable to this Court:

1. Must be with a nonprofit agency or organization.
2. Must not involve any service or work that the juvenile normally performs.
3. No monetary compensation may be received by the defendant for the community service work.

To insure that you receive proper credit for the service that you perform, make sure that the nonprofit agency or organization is informed that you are under a Court Order to perform the hours assigned and that the agency/organization completes and returns to the Court the attached Community Service Completion Form.
