Dear Property Owner or Resident:

You are invited to attend a public information meeting for the upcoming reconstruction of the 14th Street (WIS 28) bridge over the Sheboygan River in the city of Sheboygan. A project location map is attached.

The meeting will take place in the Kiwanis Fieldhouse, 726 Kiwanis Park Drive, Sheboygan, on Thursday, March 27, 2014, from 4:30 to 6 p.m. A short presentation is scheduled for 4:40 p.m. The remainder of the meeting will follow an informal open house format. Representatives of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) and city of Sheboygan will be available to discuss the proposed project and address any questions or concerns.

The proposed project will remove, widen, and replace the existing bridge deck and provide minor repairs to the structure. The roadway immediately north and south of the bridge will also be reconstructed to accommodate the widened bridge. Construction is scheduled for the summer of 2015.

If you have any questions or concerns that may assist in the development of this project, we encourage you to attend the meeting. The Kiwanis Fieldhouse is wheelchair accessible.
