



HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION

Sheboygan County Residents Only



THERE IS A \$10 PER VEHICLE CHARGE!

Have you wondered where you might be able to dispose of household hazardous waste or agricultural chemicals that are no longer usable? Hazardous waste, if not disposed of properly, can create a potential health risk to people and can threaten our environment, eventually contaminating our groundwater, rivers, and lakes.

Sheboygan County has established four collection sites for disposing of hazardous wastes, as identified on the next page. The majority of the program is funded with County tax dollars; be prepared to show proof of residency. When those funds are depleted, the sites will be closed until funds are again available.

This year's **Clean Sweep Collection Event** will take place on *May 9 and May 10*. *We encourage citizens to bring their hazardous wastes to these two collection events as much as possible.* **There will be a \$10 per vehicle charge at this event also.**

What kind of materials will be accepted at the facilities?

- * Flammable liquids
- * Oil-based paints
- * Solvents
- * Varnishes
- * Thinners
- * Most Electronics (for detailed list go to www.sheboygancounty.com and navigate to the Planning & Conservation Department website)
- * Fluorescent bulbs (household quantities)
- * Household batteries
- * Acids and bases
- * Old gasoline
- * Pesticides and herbicides
- * Cleaners
- * Aerosols
- * Poisons
- * Antifreeze
- * Reactives (typically pool chemicals)

Are there materials that **WILL NOT** be accepted? **YES! LATEX PAINT**, waste oil, radioactive materials, explosives, medical wastes, waste medications, pressurized cylinders, and tires will not be accepted.

What can I do with the unacceptable materials?

- **Waste Oil** is recycled at many sites in conjunction with community recycling programs. See the Sheboygan County Planning & Conservation website for more information. The address is www.sheboygancounty.com.
- **Latex (Water Based) Paint** is not "hazardous." It can be disposed of with regular garbage once dried. Simply remove the cover to let it dry up, or pour it out in a container and add kitty litter to help it dry up.
- **Waste Pharmaceuticals** can be recycled in the lobbies of the Sheboygan Police Department, Kohler Police Department, Sheboygan Falls Police Department, the Plymouth Police Department, and the Elkhart Lake Police Department.

ALSO, during the **May Clean Sweep Collection Event**, other accepted wastes that will be collected are:

- **Agricultural Hazardous Waste** such as pesticides, other chemicals, and pesticide containers. To dispose of these items, please call Mike Ballweg, UW-Extension, at (920) 459-5904 in advance. There may be a cost for Agricultural business wastes.
- **Very Small Quantity Generator Business Hazardous Wastes** from small businesses must call Veolia Environmental Services to pre-register their waste prior to the collection. Contact Chris Bahlow at (715) 298-2623 for a registration form. There will be a cost for disposing of these items.

What can I do if I missed the HHW collection event? Residents should visit the Sheboygan County Planning and Conservation Department's website at www.sheboygancounty.com for a schedule of the upcoming household hazardous waste collection events or call (920) 459-3060 for additional information.






