WHEREAS, there are more than 265 local chambers serving villages, towns, and cities throughout Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the chamber also promotes tourism and other community events; and

WHEREAS, the chamber also works to solve critical economic challenges, including the labor shortage, and to encourage entrepreneurship; and

WHEREAS, the Sheboygan County Chamber of Commerce is a critical community partner and problem solver with the unique ability to work with stakeholders from both the private and public sectors; and

WHEREAS, the chamber does not always receive the recognition and credit they deserve for making Sheboygan and Wisconsin a better place to live, work, and play; and

WHEREAS, the Sheboygan County Chamber of Commerce was created more than 100 years ago and currently has 853 members; and

WHEREAS, the Sheboygan County Chamber of Commerce partnered with the Sheboygan County Economic Development Corporation to develop the "Someplace Better" workforce attraction campaign;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mike Vandersteen, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Sheboygan, do hereby proclaim September 2019 as
